PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, an orgent Indorsement dated March 13, 2017 from the Office of the City Mayor was forwarded to this Sanggunian covering the request of Engr. Domardoni C. Cavanong, City General Services Officer, for a supplemental budget in the amount of THIRTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P32,300,000.00) for the purchase of Street Illumination and Lighting Fixtures using Light Emitting Diodes (LEDs);

WHEREAS, the appropriation requested is intended to cover the acquisition of around 1,640 units of warm white-90 watts LEDs to replace the existing 150 watts Sodium Lights in various barangays purposely to reduce the power consumption of the City;

WHEREAS, the move of using LED lights along city streets and barangays is anchored on the practical advantages that the city will reap through its usage. As presented by the City General Services Officer, LED lights are more environmentfriendly with 45 % less energy consumption compared to sodium lights, more durable, have low maintenance and overall, have much lower energy consumption which upon modest computation will bring about an estimated electricity consumption savings for the city of more or less P5Million in one (1) year;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian finds the proposed project as most beneficial to the City, thus the need to be funded for its immediate implementation;

WHEREAS, a certification dated March 08, 2017, from the Offices of the City Budget Officer, City Treasurer, and City Accountant was issued certifying therein that the amount of THIRTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P32,300,000.00), is deemed available to be taken from the Unappropriated Surplus, end of year 2016, for the purchase of Street Illumination and Lighting Fixtures under the account-Repair and Maintenance – other Infrastructure Assets of the General Services Office; A.O. RESOLVED, to enact:

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2017-004 (General Fund)

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P32,300,000.00), TO BE TAKEN FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS, END OF YEAR 2016, FOR THE PURCHASE OF STREET ILLUMINATION AND LIGHTING FIXTURES UNDER ACCOUNT REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE **OTHER** INFRASTRUCTURE ASSETS THE OF GENERAL SERVICES OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Fourteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc in regular session assembled, That:

SECTION 1. <u>2017 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET</u>. The sum of THIRTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P32,300,000.00), of the General Fund Supplemental Budget of Ormoc City is hereby appropriated for the purchase of Street Illumination and Lighting Fixtures under the account-Repair and Maintenance – other Infrastructure Assets of the General Services Office to be taken from the Unappropriated Surplus, end of year 2016.

SECTION 2. <u>EFFECTIVITY</u>. This Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval subject however, to the compliance of the posting and publication requirements as provided in the Local Government Code of 1991.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that sufficient copies of this Appropriation Ordinance together with all supporting documents be submitted to the Honorable Secretary, Department of Budget & Management, Manila, through the City Budget Officer of Ormoc and the Regional Director, Department of Budget & Management, Tacloban City, for review purposes;
