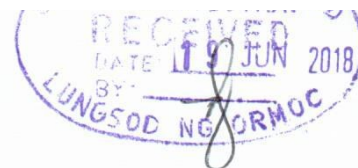

PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement Letter from the City Mayor's Office (CMO), dated April 16, 2018, requesting for a Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of SEVENTEEN MILLION PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php17, 000,000.00) to fund the purchase of One (1) lot of SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS (SWAT) TEAM EQUIPMENT intended for the Ormoc City Public Safety Company (OCPSC) personnel of the Ormoc City Police Office, and further classifying the same as URGENT;

WHEREAS, for the attainment of the policy of the State to promote peace and order, ensure public safety and further strengthen local government capability, the existence of a highly efficient and competent police force equipped with the necessary equipment is deemed utmost necessary;

WHEREAS, Section 18 of the Local Government Code provides that Local Government Units (LGUs) can apply their resources and assets for purposes in furtherance and in the attainment of national goals;

WHEREAS, the Ormoc City Police Office (OCPO) has a SWAT Team that lacks the necessary equipment to better execute their functions that include, but not limited to, hostage crisis, hostage negotiation and counter-terrorism in the City of Ormoc, and due to insufficiency of funds, the said Office had requested thru a letter dated January 18, 2018 for financial assistance from the City relative to the purchase of said equipment, a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in furtherance and support of said request, the OCPO, thru PNP City Director Police Senior Superintendent Ramil L. Ramirez, then submitted a list of the SWAT equipment needed along with the corresponding itemized budget for the same dated May 18, 2018, a copy of the same is herein attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the General Services Department (GSD) through Jose Y. Ymas, Jr. Storekeeper II which was noted by Engr. Narciso A. Emping Engr. IV, has stated in a letter dated May 25, 2018 that the aforementioned estimated cost provided by OCPO City Director Ramil L. Ramirez is just the same as with the cost in the local market, a copy of which is herein attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the City Budget Officer, OIC- City Accountant and City Treasurer issued a certification dated March 13, 2018 stating that the amount of SEVENTEEN MILLION PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php17,000,000.00) is deemed available to be taken from the Unappropriated Surplus, end of year 2017 for the purchase of one (1) lot Swat Team Equipment under the Capital Outlay Account - Military, Police and Security Equipment (Office of the City Mayor), a copy of said certification is attached as Annex "D" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon examination of the aforementioned CMO's request for supplemental appropriation for the purchase of the SWAT equipment requested by OCPO, this Sanggunian finds that the same is abundant with merit and basis, especially in light of the fact that such provision of essential SWAT equipment will significantly bolster the OCPO's crime prevention drive and thus, promote the betterment of the peace and order situation of the City and her constituents;

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on the motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Vice-Chairman, Committee on Finance and Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III and Mariano Y. Corro: be it

RESOLVED, to enact:

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2018-009
(General Fund)**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN MILLION PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php17,000,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS END OF YEAR 2017 TO PURCHASE ONE (1) LOT SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS (SWAT) TEAM EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES UNDER CAPITAL OUTLAY ACCOUNT - MILITARY, POLICE AND SECURITY EQUIPMENT (OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Fourteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc in Regular Session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. 2018 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET. The sum of SEVENTEEN MILLION PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php17,000,000.00) under Capital Outlay Account - Military, Police and Security Equipment (Office of the City Mayor) is hereby appropriated to fund the above-mentioned purchase of equipments intended to be given to the Ormoc City Police Office to be taken from Unappropriated Surplus, End of Year 2017.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVITY. This Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that sufficient copies of this Appropriation Ordinance together with all supporting documents be submitted to the Honorable Secretary, Department of Budget & Management, Manila, through the City Budget Officer, to the Regional Director, Department of Budget & Management, Tacloban City, for review purposes;

ENACTED, June 07, 2018.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, to furnish copies of this Appropriation Ordinance, one each to the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez; the City Administrator, Mr. Vincent L. Emnas; the City Legal Officer, Atty. Jasper M. Lucero; the Ormoc City Police Office Director, PSSUPT. Ramil L. Ramirez; the City Budget Officer; the OIC-City Accountant; the City Treasurer; the City Auditor; the OIC-City Director, DILG; and other offices concerned;

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.



Dear **Mayor Gomez**:

Greetings!

The maintenance of peace and order and the continued goal of strengthening our police force has always been a paramount aspect to both of the Local Government of Ormoc and of the Ormoc City Police Office wherein the abilities and skills of all OCPO personnel will always be of a prime factor in the performance of policing duties and responsibilities. Suffice it to say that to better serve the public, we need more equipped and highly trained personnel. At present, Ormoc City Police Office has a SWAT team who are lacked with formal trainings and unequipped with necessary equipment to better execute the meaning of Special Weapons and Tactics team.

The estimated worth of SWAT equipment is **seventeen-million pesos (P 17, 000,000.00)** consisting of all necessary SWAT gears.

Moreover, considering the presence of essential materials, it would be the most suitable time for the conduct of a 45-day Special Weapons and Tactics Training for the thirty-three (33) personnel from the Ormoc City Public Safety Company (OCPSC) to be conducted by trainers from the PNP Special Action Force (SAF) and to be held at Ormoc City.

Further, the estimated budgetary requirement for the said training is **one-million two-hundred ninety-six thousand three-hundred twenty-five pesos (P1, 296,325.00)**. A total of **eighteen-million two-hundred ninety-six thousand three-hundred twenty-five pesos (P18, 296, 325.00)** would considerably consist the monetary requirement to capacitate and train our Ormoc City SWAT in order to make this city a safer place to live, work and do business.

In this regard, this office is humbly requesting for a pecuniary support in the realization of a truly equipped and trained SWAT personnel.

Attached herewith are the funding requirements for your scrutiny.

We shall be profoundly grateful for your favorable consideration and approval of this request.


