PREFATORY STATEMENT

Beginning last quarter of the Year 2014, there was a series of roll back in fuel prices which led to a clamor from the general public for the corresponding decrease in the tricycle for hire fare rates.

In response to this request, the Sanggunian organized a public consultation at the Ormoc City Session Hall last January 06, 2015. The consumer group, represented by the Ormoc City Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc. (OCCI), the Ormoc Teachers Association and the Ormoc Consumer Group together with the Ormoc Tricycles Operators and Drivers Association (OMTODA) actively participated in the consultation and it was on the occasion of the same that the parties agreed that a fare decrease of One Philippine Peso (Php1.00) based on the existing fare rates would be just, fair and reasonable to all concerned. In support of its position, the OCCI has submitted a Resolution declaring the position of the OCCI on the proposed ordinance for the decrease of the tricycle fares. A copy of the said Resolution is hereto attached and marked as Annex "A" and made as an integral part of this ordinance.

As the Sanggunian likewise believes that the proposed fare reduction is proper and befitting to the present situation, hence, these amendments to Ordinance No. 166 dated April 28, 2011.

ORDINANCE NO. 010

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE 2015 FARE RATES FOR TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE IN ORMOC CITY THEREBY FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 34 ARTICLE 3, THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Thirteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Article III – FARES under Ordinance No. 34, as amended by the latest Amendatory Ordinance No. 166 dated April 28, 2011 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc is hereby further amended to read as follows:

FARES:

The fare shall be established at a level that will provide the operator and the driver a reasonable return of profit, and still be affordable to the general public.

Until such time that the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc shall prescribe otherwise, the provisional or temporary fare rates shall be in accordance with the following schedule, to wit:

The foregoing schedule of fare rates should be posted mandatorily in any part of the tricycle where said schedule can be easily seen by the passenger thereof. Failure to observe this requirement constitute a violation to this ordinance thereby making the operator and/or the driver of the tricycle liable to the penalty provided for in Article VII – Final Provisions, Section 2, Penal Provisions, Par. (b) of Ordinance No. 34. Furthermore, said schedule of fare rates shall be posted in three (3) conspicuous public places in the city and shall also be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in Ormoc City;

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 34, as amended, which are not affected by this latest amendment remains to be in full force and in effect.
