PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, there is a significant increase of the premium gasoline which has already stabilized at Fifty Pesos (P50.00) and up level;

WHEREAS, the Ormoc Motorized Tricycles Operators and Drivers Association (OMTODA) conducted its officers' meeting for the purpose of creating a resolution to address said increase;

WHEREAS, this 13th Sangguniang Panlungsod is in receipt of an indorsement dated 16 June 2015 relative to the request of the OMTODA pursuant to its resolution **"Requesting this august Body thru the recommendation of the Committee on Transportation and the Office of the City Licensing and Franchising to allow motorcab drivers to collect fare based on the Original Tariffa (with Minimum Rate of P7.00), not on the Provisional Tariffa";**

WHEREFORE, FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of Honorable SP Member Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Chairman, Committee on Transportation and Communication, severally seconded by SP Members Antonio M. Codilla, Vincent L. Rama, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II and Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, to enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 013

AN ORDINANCE REESTABLISHING THE 2015 TARIFFA FOR TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE IN ORMOC CITY PRESCRIBING NEW FARE RATES THEREBY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10 THEREBY FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.34, THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Thirteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc in regular session assembled, that:

Ord. No. 013

SECTION 1. Article III – FARES under Ordinance No. 34, as amended by the latest Amending Ordinance No. 10 dated January 14, 2015 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc is hereby further amended to read as follows:

FARES:

The fare shall be established at a level that will provide the operator and the driver a reasonable return of profit, and still be affordable to the general public.

Until such time that the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc shall prescribe otherwise, the provisional or temporary fare rates be changed to the original tariff and shall be in accordance with the following schedule, to wit:

The foregoing schedule of fare rates should be posted mandatorily in any part of the tricycle where said schedule can be easily seen by the passenger thereof. Failure to observe this requirement constitute a violation of this ordinance thereby making the operator and/or the driver of the tricycle liable to the penalty provided for in Article VII – Final Provisions, Section 2, Penal Provisions, Par, (b) of Ordinance No. 34. Furthermore, said schedule of fare rates shall be posted in three (3) conspicuous public places in the city and shall also be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in Ormoc City;

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Ordinance no. 34, as amended, which are not affected by this latest amendment remains to be in full force and in effect.

SECTION 3. All existing Ordinances, Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are considered repealed or modified accordingly, as the case may be.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance of the posting and publication requirements provided in the Local Government Code.

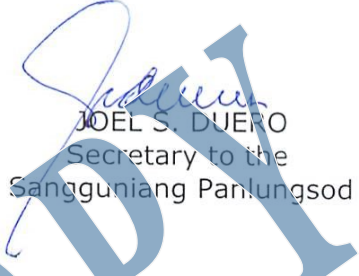

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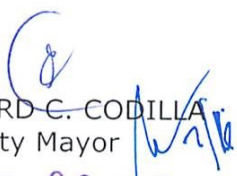
