Prefatory Statement

A public consultation for a possible reduction of the current motorcab fare rates was organized by the Committee on Transportation and Communication of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc chaired by the Hon. Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga at the SP Session Hall last February 24, 2016.

It was attended by the consumer's group represented by the Ormoc Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc., Ormoc Teacher's Association, Public Market Association, Sustainable Organic Farming Advocates, Naungan Fishermen's Organization, Hot Fm radio station, Business Permits & Licensing Office together with the Ormoc Tricycles Operator's and Drivers Association (OMTODA).

As of the present, the price of the unleaded gasoline is Forty Pesos (P 40.00) and for the premium it's Forty One Pesos (P 41.00) in major gasoline stations in Ormoc City as of February 24, 2016.

This Sanggunian believes that the proposed fare reduction of One Peso (P 1.00) on the current motorcab fare rates as prescribed in Ordinance No. 013 enacted on July 02, 2015 is proper and befitting to the present situation hence, the need for its immediate amendment.

ORDINANCE NO. 025

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE 2016 FARE RATES FOR TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE IN ORMOC CITY THEREBY FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 34 ARTICLE 3, THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Thirteenth Sangguniang Panglungsod ng Ormoc in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Article III – FARES under Ordinance No. 34, as amended by the latest Amendatory Ordinance No. 013 dated July 02, 2015 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc are hereby further amended to read as follows:

FARES:

The fare shall be established at a level that will provide the operator and the driver a reasonable return of profit, and still be affordable to the general public.

Until such time that the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc shall prescribe otherwise, the official fare rates shall be in accordance with the following schedule, to wit:

The foregoing schedule of fare rates should be posted mandatorily in any part of the tricycle where said schedule can be easily seen by the passenger thereof. Failure to observe this requirement constitute a violation to this ordinance thereby making the operator and/or the driver of the tricycle liable to the penalty provided for in Article Ordinance No. 34. Furthermore, said schedule of fare rates shall be posted in three (3) conspicuous public places in the city and shall also be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in Ormoc City;

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 34, as amended, which are not affected by this latest amendment remains to be in full force and in effect.

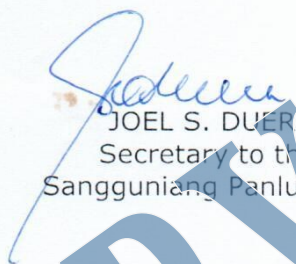
SECTION 3. All existing Ordinances, Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are considered repealed or modified accordingly, as the case may be.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it shall have been published once in a local newspaper of general circulation within the City of Ormoc and posted in public places for at least three (3) consecutive weeks.

ENACTED, March 21, 2016.

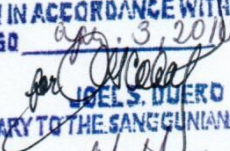
