PREFATORY STATEMENT

City Ordinance No. 035, Series of 2017 was approved by the 14th Sangguriang Panlungsod with the main purpose of easing traffic congestion in the main thoroughfares of the city and providing the public of a regulated, systematic, convenient, safe and comfortable public terminal.

For the safety of pedestrians, the riding public and with the ultimate view of decongesting traffic in the City proper of Ormoc City, this Sanggunian, after the passage of such Ordinance, observed the need to amend a provision of the same in order to cause a smooth, orderly and efficient implementation of said Ordinance, particularly during the initial transition period when certain North-bound Public Utility Vehicles (PUVs) shall be re-assigned or re-deployed to the new Terminal. Hence, the need to amend and strengthen the existing Ordinance through herein amendatory ordinance for said purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II and Esteban V. Laurente; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 075

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 35 SERIES OF 2017, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ORMOC CITY NORTH TRANSPORT TERMINAL ORDINANCE OF 2017".

BE IT ENACTED, by the Fourteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 35 Series of 2017, otherwise known as the "Ormoc City North Transport Terminal Ordinance of 2017", hereinafter referred to as the "amended Ordinance", shall now read as follows:

"SECTION 5. Rules and Regulations. The following rules and regulations shall be observed in the operation of the Terminal:

a) Only North-bound PUJs, Multicabs, GT Express, PUmBS and PUBs with approved routes may be required to enter Terminal to load or unload their passengers but not to the prejudice of loading or unloading passengers in between the point of origin and point of destination;

SECTION 2. If, for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. All existing ordinances and parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby deemed repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance of the requirements of the Local Government Code of 1991.
