"MENTAS, Ormoc City High School Parent-Teacher Asso-ciation (CASPIA) in its Resolution No. 1, current series, has requested the City Administration to increase the salaries of the teachers to r600.00 a month each as it has been observed that elementary school teachers are receiving more, and in Resolution No. 2 and No. 3 has requested the standar-dization of the yearly tuition fees of high school students-tollo ing a regulation of the Ministry of Education and Culture that faition fees should not be less than P100.00 per school year inasmuch as the present tuition fee of P70.00 is even far below those imposed by the rural high schools;

"WHEREAS, this august Body finds the requests of the OCHSPTA meritorious considering Budget Circular No. 78-290 dated June 1, 1978, adjusting the salaries of secondary school teachers to not less than \$574.00 per month even as we consider the association's request for standardization we consider the association's request for standardization of the tuition fees to P110.00 for first year, P120.00 for second year, P130.00 for third year, and P140 for fourth year students which, even if raised to P120.00, P125.00, P135.00, and P145.00, respectively, would still be very much less than tuition fees imposed by the two private schools in the city;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Torrevillas, seconded by Kagawad Mendola; be it

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. Amendment. - Section 4.1.7.1 of Article 13, Tax Ordinance No. 1, otherwise known as the "Ormoc City Revenue Code of 1977," is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.1.7.1. Imposition of Fees. - Except as hereinafter provided, the following fees shall be paid by each student enrolled in the Ormoc City High School, to wit:

2.00	P120.00 125.00 135.00 145.00
	2.00 2.00 2.00

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That if a student is a non-resident of Ormoc City he shall pay an additional amount of ten pesos (P10.00), said amount to be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the collection of matriculation fees prescribed herein."

SECTION 2. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect upon the approval of the Ministry of Education and Culture.
