TAX ORDINANCE NO. 93-05

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE SCHEDULE OF CIVIL REGISTRY  
FEES IN ORMOC CITY.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Article X, Section 5 of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines, which grants to each Local Government Unit the power to create its own source of revenue and levy taxes, fees and charges subject to such guidelines and limitations as the Congress may provide consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy, which taxes, fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the Local Government Unit. Likewise, this Tax Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Section 18, 151, 186 and 187 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

On motion of Kagawad Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Benjamin B. Lladoc and Angelyn R. Paca; be it

ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Preliminary Title - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the 1993 Local Civil Registry Fees of Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. Schedule of Civil Registry Fees - The following fees shall be imposed and collected:

A.1 Birth Certificate

SECTION 3. Registration of births, marriages, deaths and foundling -  
The registration of births, marriages, deaths and foundling when done within  
thirty (30) days from the date of birth, marriage, death and finding  
abandoned child shall be free from the payment of any fees whatsoever.

However, if the registration of such births, marriages, deaths and  
foundling is done beyond the period prescribed above, the registration  
thereof shall be subject to the following fees: One Peso (P1.00) for every  
year of delay or fraction thereof, plus: P30.00 if the delay in the  
registration does not exceed ten (10) years; P50.00 if the delay in the  
registration exceeds ten (10) years but is not over twenty (20) years; and  
P100.00 if the delay in the registration exceeds twenty (20) years.

SECTION 4. All the fees mentioned herein shall be paid to the City  
Treasurer who shall acknowledge properly the receipt thereof. The Local  
Civil Registrar shall indicate the official receipt number and the date of  
its issuance in the document issued by him for which payment is due.

SECTION 5. The Civil Registrar shall issue certified copies of  
documents or certifications free of charge if the same shall be used for the  
following purposes:

1. Birth certificates of children reaching school age when required  
for admission to the primary grades of the public schools;
2. Request of competent court or other governmental agencies.  
Governmental agencies refer to the Republic of the Philippines,  
Provinces, Municipalities, Cities, Barangays, and other  
departments of the government, but do not include government owned  
or controlled corporations.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause - If for any reason any provision  
hereof is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions  
which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and  
effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause - All Ordinances or provisions of  
ordinances which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are considered  
repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 1993.

SECTION 9. Within five (5) days after the approval of this Ordinance, copies thereof shall be posted in at least two (2) conspicuous and publicly accessible places.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Tax Ordinance each to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Treasurer, the City Civil Registrar's Office, the City Auditor, and others concerned, -all in Ormoc City;

ENACTED, August 19, 1993.


