PREFATORY STATEMENT

This Sanggunian is in receipt of a letter dated December 22, 1999  
from HON. EUFRACINO M. CODILLA, SR., City Mayor of Ormoc City proposing  
to increase the fees/charges in the services of the City Health Office.

The City Health Office is undergoing an upgrading of its services  
for the populace of Ormoc City with the construction of modern X-ray  
facility and laboratory. Also, in order to cope up with the increasing  
cost of laboratory reagents and solutions it uses during examinations.  
The present rates of the fees and charged are no longer realistic  
considering the present value of our money, and the growing financial  
needs of the City Government in order to support the health needs and  
services for the people. Hence, the need to upgrade the rates and fees  
of charges provided in the aforementioned Tax Ordinance. Moreover,  
Article 10, Section 5 of our Constitution grants to Local Government  
Units the power to create its own source of revenues and levy taxes,  
fees and charges subject to such guidelines and limitation as the  
Congress may provide consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy  
which taxes, fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the Local  
Government Unit. The aforecited Constitutional provision is likewise  
buttressed and implemented by the provision of our Local Government Code  
(RA 7160, specifically, Section 186 thereof which reads: "Local  
Government may exercise the power to levy taxes, fees or charges on any  
base or subject not otherwise specifically enumerated herein or taxed  
under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended,  
or other applicable laws; Provided, That the taxes, fees, or charges")

shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy; Provided, further, That the Ordinance levying such taxes, fees or charges shall not be enacted without any prior Public Hearing conducted for the purposes".

FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of Councilor Dennis Y. Capuyan, Chairman, Committee on Health, Public and Social Welfare, Women and Family, jointly seconded by City Councilors Fernando P. Parrilla and Eduardo P. Tan; be it

RESOLVED, to enact:

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 2000-003

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES OF X-RAY SERVICE AND INCREASING THE CHARGES FOR THE USE OF OTHER FACILITIES AT THE ORMOC CITY HEALTH OFFICE, THEREBY AMENDING PAR. C SECTION 12, TAX ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES OF 1986.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE 8TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, in regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES/CHARGES FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES AT THE ORMOC CITY HEALTH OFFICE.

SECTION 2. The following rates shall be implemented as follows:

A Permit to discharge Septic Tank shall be secured from the City Health Office and the location for the disposal shall be jointly approved by the Environment & Natural Resources Division and City Health Office.

The fees shall be paid to the City Treasurer's Office or its duly authorized representative, upon order of payment by the City Health Officer.

SECTION 3. The above fees with asterisk (\*) will not be collected if the patient has been certified indigent by the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO).

SECTION 4. In case of changes in the cost of materials used in the X-ray, laboratory and dental services a corresponding adjustment as to the fees shall be made thru an Executive Order, upon recommendation of the City Health Officer.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In case any provision of this Ordinance shall be held or decided as invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the other provisions thereof shall not be affected thereof.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE - Any Ordinance, rules and regulations or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication in the newspaper of local circulation.
