

PREFATORY STATEMENT

PRESENTED to this Sanggunian for consideration is an indorsement dated June 15, 2011 from the Office of the City Mayor in connection with the proposed realignment of various unfunded development projects/programs under the 20% Development Fund of the City of Ormoc. The matter was the subject of the communication sent by Engr. Dario Sarit, Planning Officer IV of the City Planning and Development Office which includes the listing of the projects/programs to be realigned and to be funded from out of the Reversion of Continuing Appropriations totaling NINETEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND TWENTY SIX PESOS & 65/100 (P19,572,026.65).

Anent this matter, the City Budget Officer issued a Certification dated June 13, 2011 stating that the funds subject for reversion are available from the Continuing Appropriations which amount may be utilized to fund the various realigned projects/programs under the 20% Development Fund, which is in compliance with DILG/DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2011-1 dated April 13, 2011.

The City Treasurer, through a Certificate of Availability of Funds dated June 14, 2011 also certified that the amount of NINETEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND TWENTY SIX PESOS & 65/100 (P19,572,026.65) are available through reversion of the Continuing Appropriations and the same may be used as a funding source of the various development projects/programs under the 20% Development Fund which are proposed to be realigned.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Twelfth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. <u>2011 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET</u>. The sum of NINETEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND TWENTY SIX PESOS & 65/100 (P19,572,026.65) of the General Fund Supplemental Budget of Ormoc City is hereby reverted and appropriated for the various development projects/ programs under the 20% Development Fund for realignment be taken from out of the reversion of Continuing Appropriations.

SECTION 2. <u>EFFECTIVITY</u>. This Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that sufficient copies of this Appropriation Ordinance, together with all supporting documents thereof, be submitted to the Honorable Secretary of Department of Budget and Management, Manila, through the City Budget Officer of Ormoc, and the Regional Director, Department of Budget & Management, Tacloban City, for review purposes;

ENACTED, July 14, 2011.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, to furnish copies of this Appropriation Ordinance, one each to His Honor, the City Mayor Eric C. Codilla; the City Administrator; the City Treasurer; the City Budget Officer; the City Accountant; the City Auditor; the City Planning & Development Office; and other offices concerned.
