ORDINANCE NO. 1

On motion of Councilor Wenceslao Pongos, seconded
by Councilor Andres Masias,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE REGULATING THE
CONSTRUCTION OF TEMPORARY STRUCTURES OR SHACKS, AND PRESCRIB-
ING PENALTIES THEREWITH".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of Ormoc,
Leyte, Philippines, that:

SECTION 1.- This Ordinance shall be known as "THE RE-
GULATORY ORDINANCE ON SHACK-BUILDING AND OTHER PURPOSES".

SECTION 2.- Hereafter, to promote the general health,
welfare, and comfort of the people living in this municipality,
no temporary structure for living purposes, whether roofed
with cogon, nipa, or otherwise, shall be built without comply-
ing with the following conditions:

- (a) If along the road, the temporary structures or
shacks shall be, at least, fifteen feet (or 4-1/2 meters) there-
from and the neighboring shacks;
- (b) Temporary structures or shacks in the interior shall
be, at least, fifteen feet from its neighbors measured from
their nearest points;
- (c) The toilet and the kitchen shall be behind the tem-
porary structures or shacks, but where the toilet is separate,
same shall be fifteen feet from any neighboring shack or toilet;
and,
- (d) Toilets shall be always covered, whether or not they
form a part of the shacks.

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SECTION 3.- Any person who desires to construct a temporary structure or shack in the poblacion of Ormoc, Leyte, shall first procure a permit to do so, either in person or in writing, from the office of the Municipal Mayor of this municipality;

SECTION 4.- Any person violating any provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one month, or by a fine of not more than ₱200.00, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 5.- All previous ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
