ORDINANCE NO. 11

On motion of Councilor Andres Masias, seconded by Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 AND PARAGRAPH -A- THEREOF OF ORDINANCE NO. 6, CS, STRIKING OUT THEREFROM- (1) THE CLAUSE 'FOR LIVING PURPOSES' AND (2) THE REQUIRED DISTANCES BETWEEN NEIGHBORING HOUSES ALONG THE ROAD- IN ORDER TO READ AS FOLLOWS:"

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte, Philippines, that:

SECTION 1.- Hereafter, to promote the general health, welfare, and comfort of the people living in this Municipality, no structure or shack, whether roofed with cogen, nipa, or otherwise, shall be built along the road unless it is fifteen feet (or 4-1/2 meters) therefrom measured from the outer edge thereof.

SECTION 2.- Any person, firm or corporation violating the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by the penalty as provided in Section 4 of Ordinance No. 6, cs.

SECTION 3.- All other previous ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
