ORDINANCE NO. 12

On motion of Councilor Wenceslao Pongos, seconded
by Councilor Restituto Cabiling,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL
EMPLOYEES AND LABORERS IN ANY CAFE, RESTAURANT, OR HOTEL OPE-
RATING WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THIS MUNICIPALITY TO SUBMIT
FOR MEDICAL OR PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND TO PAY MEDICAL CERTI-
FICATE AT ₱1.00, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR".

BE IT ORDAINED by the authority of the Municipal Coun-
cil of this Municipality that:

SECTION I.- In order to safeguard the health and pro-
mote the general welfare of the public, henceforth, all em-
ployees and laborers in any cafe, restaurant and hotel ope-
rated within the jurisdiction of this Municipality shall sub-
mit for medical or physical examination to the local health
officer or his duly authorized representative, and re-examina-
tion not later than the end of every three months thereafter.

SECTION II.- For every medical certificate issued by
the local health officer or his duly authorized representative
in favor of the individual employee or laborer, the person so
examined shall be required to pay fee of ₱1.00 to the Muni-
cipal Treasurer of this Municipality or his duly authorized
representative.

SECTION III.- Owners or proprietors of cafes, restau-
rants, or hotels shall submit lists of their respective em-
ployees and laborers immediately after their receipt of the
copies of this

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copies of this ordinance.

SECTION IV.- Any person or persons, firm or corporation found violating any provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than P10.00 or an imprisonment of not more than 10 days, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION V.- All previous ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or portions hereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI.- This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
