ORDINANCE NO. 13

On motion of Councilor Wenceslao Pengos, seconded by Councilor Paster C. Tan,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE CALLED AS THE PROHIBITORY ORDINANCE ON EXPLOSIVES AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR".

BE IT ORDAINED by the authority of the Municipal Council of this Municipality, that:

SECTION I.- Hereafter, in order to protect and safeguard the lives of the inhabitants, no person, firm or corporation shall be allowed to possess, handle, take, carry or sell explosives without permit from proper authorities.

SECTION II.- Any person, firm or corporation found violating the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than P50.00 nor more than P200.00, or by imprisonment of not less than 1 month nor more than 4 months, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION III.- All previous ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
