ORDINANCE NO. 15

On motion of Councilor Wenceslao Pongos, seconded by Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE DECLARING MARKET ZONE AT CAN-ADYENG, ORMOC, HEREWITH REQUIRING VENDORS OF TIENDAS THEREIN TO PAY MARKET FEES AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR".

BE IT ORDAINED by the authority of the Municipal Council of this Municipality that:

SECTION I.- Hereafter, the area herein-below described shall be declared "MARKET ZONE" during the existence of the Temporary Municipal Market Building situated therein:

This area is situated at Can-adyeng; bounded on the North, by the Malabasag River; on the East, by the Provincial Road; on the South, by the Can-adyeng Creek; and on the West, by the Ormoc Bay.

SECTION II.- Any person, firm or corporation having 'tiendas' within the market zone but outside the market building shall pay half of the usual market fees charged to those vendors inside the said market building;

SECTION III.- Any person, firm or corporation found violating the provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ₱1.00 nor more than ₱5.00, or by imprisonment of not less than 1 day nor more than 5 days, or both, at the discretion of the Court.
