ORDINANCE NO. 16

On motion of Councilor Wenceslao Pongos, seconded by
Councilor Restituto Cabiling,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE SUBJECTING FOR
SANITARY INSPECTION COMMODITY OR COMMODITIES FOR HUMAN CON-
SUMPTION BROUGHT INTO THIS PORT OF ORMOC BY MEANS OF LAUNCHES,
BANCAS, OR ANY WATER CONVEYANCE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED by the authority of the Municipal Coun-
cil of this Municipality that:

SECTION I.- Hereafter, no commodity or commodities for
human consumption brought into this port of Ormoc, Leyte, by
means of launches, bancas, or any water conveyance shall be
unloaded, disposed, or sold unless the same are duly inspected
by the local health authorities.

SECTION II.- Any person, firm or corporation found
violating the provision of this ordinance shall be punished
by a fine of not more than ₱200.00, or by imprisonment of not
more than 4 months, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION III.- All previous ordinances in conflict
with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.- This ordinance shall take effect imme-
