## ORDINANCE NO.18

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SAME OF FOODSTUFFS WORTH.

NOT LESS THAN FIVE PESOS (\$5.00) IN BARRIOS OF CAN-ADYENG,
ALEGRIA, COGON COMBADO, AND WILL POBLACION OF ORMOC, LEYTE,
PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION DEEREOF.

BE IT ENACED by the authority of the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte, that:

SECTION I.- Hereafter, no person shall peddle any foodstuffs worth not less than P5.00 in the barries of Canadyeng, Alecria, Coron Combado, and the Poblacion of Ormoc, Leyte, without paying the requisite fee therefor to the Municipal Treasurer or any of his deputies.

deputies shall have fixed stand in the market zone to facilitate the paying of market fees.

SECTION III. The Municipal Treasurer or any of his deputies assigned in said market zone shall be charged with the duty of appraising the value of foodstuffs, the determination of their fitness for public consumption and the issuance of peddler's tickets upon payment of the required fee.

SECTION IV. - The schedule of fees for the purposes of this ordinance shall be as follows:

SECTION V.- In the case of foodstuffs peddled which are to be weighed or measured, the peddlers thereof shall be required to have the required standard licensed weights or measures as the case may be in addition to the payment of the fees.

SECTION VI.- Any person, firm or corporation, found violating the provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$\P\$5.00 nor more than \$\P\$60.00, or by imprisonment of not less than 5 days nor more than 2 months, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION VII. - All other previous ordinance or portion thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VIII. - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

Originally, this ordinance was sponsored by Councilor Paster C. Tan, and seconded by Councilor Guillerme Parrilla during the previous regular session. It was laid on the table for further study. After therough deliberation, it was actually UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.
