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ORDINANCE NO. 2

On motion of Vice-Mayor Perfirio Ayuyao, seconded by Councilor Saturnino Villoria,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ALIENATION AND TRANSPORTATION OF WORK ANIMALS IN FAVOR OF PERSONS LIVING OUTSIDE THE MUNICIPALITY OF ORMOC, LEYTE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte, Philippines, that:

SECTION 1.- This Ordinance shall be known as "THE EMERGENCY PROHIBITORY ORDINANCE ON THE ALIENATION AND TRANSPORTATION OF WORK ANIMALS IN FAVOR OF PERSONS LIVING OUTSIDE THE MUNICIPALITY OF ORMOC, LEYTE.

SECTION 2.- Hereafter, in order to prevent the future shortage of work animals in this municipality, no person, firm, or corporation shall be allowed to alienate any carabao or carabaos in favor of persons living outside the municipality of Ormoc, Leyte: PROVIDED, however, that non-resident purchasers of work animals who have no intention of transporting them outside the limits thereof, the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply.

SECTION 3.- Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment of not more than one month, or by a fine of not more than P50.00, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4.- All previous ordinances or portions thereof
