ORDINANCE NO. 21

On motion of Councilor Andres Masias, seconded by Councilor Victorio Laurente,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE REQUIRING HEADS OF FAMILIES TO REPORT SOJOURNERS OR NON-RESIDENTS WITHIN RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE HEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council and by authority in it vested by Section 2276 of the Revised Administrative Code as amended, that:

SECTION 1.- Every head of a family is hereby required to report immediately to the head of the Volunteer Patrol of the barrio or sitio in which he resides all non-residents temporarily sojourning within his household.

SECTION 2.- This report should contain the name, sex, age, civil status, occupation, permanent address, and any other information regarding the sojourner for police purposes.

SECTION 3.- The head of the Volunteer Patrol shall immediately submit to the Municipal Mayor all such names reported to him.

SECTION 4.- Failure on the part of the head of the family or heads of Volunteer Patrols as above referred to will subject the offender to imprisonment of not more than 3 months or fine of not more than ₱90.00, or both, at the dis-

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cretion of the Court.

SECTION 5.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Provincial Governor.
