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ORDINANCE NO. 3

On motion of Councilor Andres Masias, seconded by
Councilor Wenceslao Pongos,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE REQUIRING EVERY
MALE RESIDENT OF THE PBLACION OF ORMOC, LEYTE, TO BE A MEMBER
OF THE FIRE BRIGADE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION
THEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte,
Philippines, that:

SECTION 1.- This Ordinance shall be known as "THE COM-
PULSORY ORDINANCE ON ALL MALE RESIDENTS OF THIS MUNICIPALITY TO
BE MEMBERS OF A FIRE BRIGADE".

SECTION 2.- Hereafter, every abled-bodied resident of
the poblacion of Ormoc, Leyte, from 16 to 60 years old are re-
quired to be a member of the fire brigade to be organized by and
placed under the supervision and management of the Chief of
Police of the Municipality of Ormoc, Leyte.

SECTION 3.- The Chief of Police concerned shall divide
the poblacion of Ormoc into 4 districts, each to be under a
district leader.

SECTION 4.- Any person violating the provisions of this
ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment of not more than 10
days, or by a fine of not more than ₱10.00, or both, in the
discretion of the Court.

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SECTION 5.- All previous ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
