ORDINANCE NO. 5

On motion of Councilor Andres Masias, seconded by  
Councilor Victorio Laurente,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY  
UNAUTHORIZED INDIVIDUAL TO ENTER AND GET SOMETHING FROM ANY  
LOT OR HOUSE NOT BELONGING TO HIM, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES  
FOR VIOLATION THEREFOR".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte,  
Philippines, that:

SECTION 1.- Hereafter, no person, firm or corporation  
shall enter and get something from any lot or house situated  
in the Poblacion of Ormoc without the knowledge and consent of  
the owner thereof.

SECTION 2.- Any person, firm or corporation violating  
the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by imprison-  
ment of not more than one month, or by a fine of not more than  
P30,00, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3.- All previous ordinances or portions thereof  
in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon ap-  
proval.
