ORDINANCE NO. 8

On motion of Vice-Mayor Porfirio Ayuyao, seconded by Councilor Andres Masias,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt an "ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RESTRICTION UPON SLAUGHTER OF LARGE CATTLE AND IMPOSING GRADUATED SLAUGHTER FEES THEREOF".

BE IT ENACTED by authority of the Municipal Council of Ormoc, Leyte, that:

SECTION I.- This Ordinance shall be known as the REGULATORY ORDINANCE ON LARGE CATTLE".

SECTION II.- Hereafter, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to slaughter large cattle for either domestic or public consumption, or both, without complying with the following regulations:-

1.- Applicant for slaughter permit shall cause his large cattle to be verified and examined, for approval or disapproval, by the COMMITTEE OF THREE created under Resolution No. 47, cs, of the Municipal Council of this Municipality whose members are the following:

2.- The applicant for slaughter permit shall be required to pay to the Municipal Treasurer of this Municipality or his duly authorized representative for the traveling expenses of the Committee and for the slaughter fee under the following schedule:

3.- The applicant for slaughter permit shall be required to pay for the traveling expenses of the Committee concerned regardless whether or not his application is approved.

SECTION III.- Any person, firm or corporation who shall intentionally slaughter large cattle for either domestic or public consumption, or both, without the necessary permit shall be required to pay to the Municipal Treasurer or his duly authorized representative an amount of P100.00 as slaughter fee therefor.

SECTION IV.- No permit shall be granted by the Municipal Treasurer or any of his duly authorized representative without the report of the Committee concerned.

SECTION V.- Any person, firm or corporation violating the provision or provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment of not more than six months, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION VI.- All previous ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
