ORDINANCE NO. 2

On motion of Councilor Lourdes Codilla, seconded
by Councilor Lucilo Conui,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING
ALL BUILDING CONTRACTORS TO PAY LICENSES AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE THEREWITH".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of this City
of Ormoc and by authority of the same, that:

SECTION 1.- Hereafter, no building contractor
shall be allowed to engage in building constructions with-
in the jurisdiction of this City of Ormoc unless Municipal
license tax therefor shall have been procured from the
Office of the City Treasurer hereof or from any of his duly
authorized representative in the amount of ₱25.00 per an-
num in conformity with the City Ordinance No.1, current
series.

SECTION 2.- For purposes of this ordinance, a
building contractor shall be defined as any person, as-
sociation or corporation who contracts or caused to be
constructed for specific or definite amount either for ser-
vices rendered only or for both labor and materials for
the construction of any house, building or edifice, com-
mercial or residential.

SECTION 3.- Any building contractor found violat-
ing the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by
a fine of not more than ₱200.00 or an imprisonment of not
more than one month or both such fine and imprisonment at
the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4.- All previous ordinances or portions

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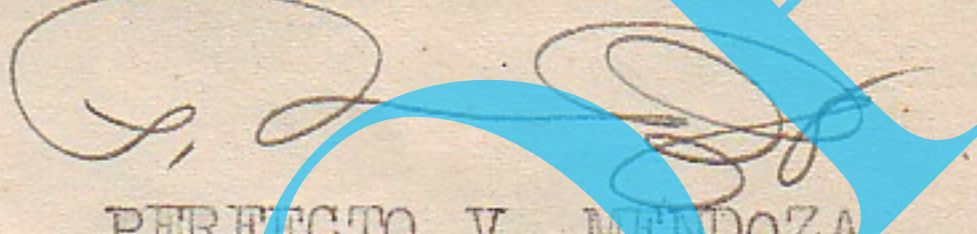
thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

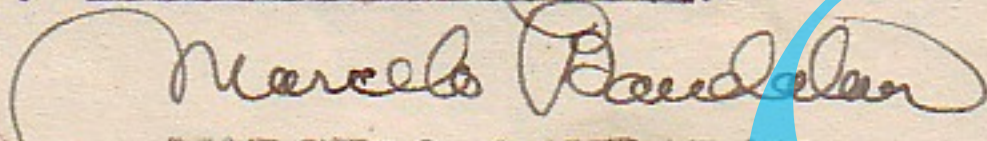
