ORDINANCE NO. 5

On motion of Councilor Margarito Tugonon, se-
conded by Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros,

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt "A REGULATORY ORDI-
NANCE REGARDING "SPEED LIMIT" FOR ALL KINDS OF MOTOR
VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND SCHOOL ZONES AND
PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of this
City of Ormoc and by authority of the same, that:

SECTION 1.- Hereafter, all parties concerned
should strictly observe the following SPEED LIMITS for
all kinds of motor vehicles while in places herein-after
specified, to wit:

Within city Limits	10 miles per hour
While approaching school zones	10 miles per hour
Within school zones	5 miles per hour

SECTION 2.- School Zones referred to in Sec-
tion 1 of this ordinance includes all school zones in
all barrios and districts of the City of Ormoc passable
by vehicles.

SECTION 3.- For purposes of this ordinance, the
school authorities concerned shall place SIGNBOARDS on

both directions of the road or street affected, each 50 lineal meters distant from the gate of the school and bearing the following warnings:

" SCHOOL ZONE
Drive Slow! 5 MPH"

and the City Engineer shall likewise place SIGNBOARDS on the Ormoc-Merida Junction and Camp Dawnes Bridge with the following warnings:

" CITY LIMITS
Drive Slow! 10 MPH"

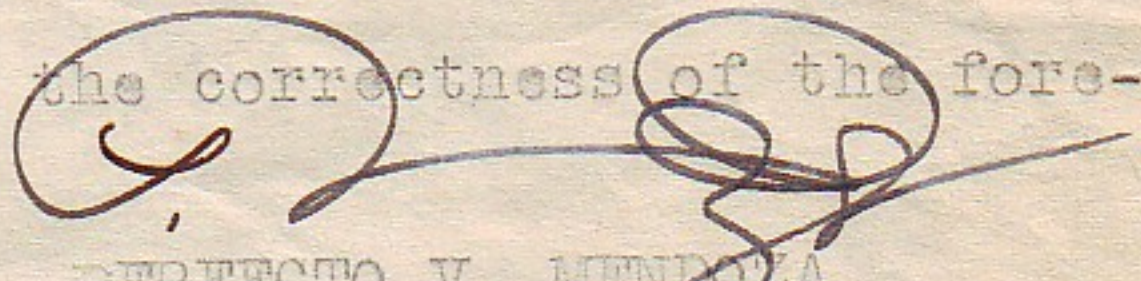
SECTION 4.- Any person or persons, firm or corporation found violating, directly or indirectly, the provision or provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than ₱200.00 or an imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 5.- All previous ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provision or provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
