RESOLUTION NO. 219

The Board, on mtion of Honorable Councilor Tugonon
seconded by Honorable Councilor Teleron, hereby repealed and
suspended Ordinance No. 11 under Resolution No. 189 current
series of the Municipal Board, Ormoc City and enacted the
following Ordinance, to wit;

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND REGULATIN THE COLLECTION
OF WHARP OR PIER CHARGES IN THE USE OF PORT FACILITIES

Be it Ordained by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City
Philippines, that;

SECTION1.- Every vessel propelled by steam or internal
combustion engines and engaged in the Philippine coastwise
trade, excepting boats of five tons gross or less or pleasure
or non-commercial craft which berths at a pier, wharf, bulkhead
wharf, river or channel marginal wharf at the port of Ormoc
City, Philippines, provided with cargo sheds or makes fast to
any vessel lying at such wharf or pier, for the purpose of
loading or discharging cargo or for any other purpose except
when in distress, shall pay a berthing fee of one half centavo
(P0.005) per registered gross ton for the first twenty four
(24) hours or part thereof; Provided, that the maximum charge
shall not exceed Fifty Pesos(P50.00) for the first day thereof
nor shall the minimum charges be less than Five(P5.00) Pesos for
the first day and Two Pesos(P2.50) and fifty centavos for each
succeeding day or part thereof; and Provided further, that steam
or motor vessel subject to berthing fees are herein prescribed
of less than 100 groww ton shall be subject to a minimum charge
of not less than Two(P2.00) pesos for the first day and one
(P1.00) Peso for each sacceeding day or part thereof.

(b) Every vessel propelled by steam or internal combus-
tion engine and engaged in coastwise trade which berths at a
pier, wharf, bulkhead wharf, river or channel marginal wharf
without a cargo shed at Ormoc City Port of makes fast to any
vessel lying at such pier, wharf, bulkhead wharf, river, or
channel marginal wharf for any purpose except those specifi-
cally exempted in the preceeding subparagraph shall pay a berth
ing pay of one fourth (P0.0025) for registered gross ton or vessel

for the first twenty four hours or part thereof and on eight(P0.00125) per registered greoss ton of vessel for each succeeding twenty four (24) hours or part thereof. Provided, that the maximum charge shall not exceed twelve pesos and fifty centavos(P12.50) for the first day and six pesos(P6.00) for each succeeding day of part thereof nor shall the minimum charge be less than fifty centavos(P0.50) for the first day or paet thereof.

SECTION 2.- Any vessel owned by the government of the Philippines not engaged in the carrying cargo or passengers shall be exempt from payment of berthing fees.

SECTION 3.- Any person, firm, company or corporation found violatin the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Pesos(P200.00) and in the dase of Corporation or company the Manager of president thereof as the case may be shall be the one responsible.

SECTION 4.- Collection of berthing from this Ordinance shall be credited to a Special fund and used only for the main tenance and improvements of the port at which the collections are made.

SECTION 5.- All previous Ordiances or portions thereof in conflict with this Ordiances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.- The Ordiance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
