RESOLUTION NO. 237

The proposed Ordinance for the Slaughter and Market Fees, submitted by the Market Superintendent of Ormoc City, Mr. Francisco Arradaza, was presented for the consideration of the Board.

The Board, on motion of Honorable Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Honorable Councilor Teleron, enacted the proposed Ordinance, as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING MARKET AND SLAUGHTER FEES UPON PERSONS, COMPANIES, FIRM OR CORPORATIONS ENGAGED IN VARIOUS BUSINESSES WITHIN THE PUBLIC MARKET BUILDING AND ITS PREMISES AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE.

By authority of Section 15 of Republic Act No. 179, be it ordained by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City that:

SECTION 1.-Market Vendor.- There shall be levied and collected from each and every person, company, firm or corporation engaged in any business within the public market buildings and its premises, the following market and slaughter fees:

SECTION 2. Fresh Fish.—For purposes of this Ordinance
the different kinds of fishes sold in the public market are
hereby classified and the corresponding market fees fixed, as
follows:

First Class:	Tangigui, jass-an, mahinio, tangarong, mapati, borao, bolis, mangai, baniscol, bulis, bulis, nanangbo, sawyanon, ulai, banabha-on, bahalo pugapo, bat-eg, tuling, kitong, ketaabak, saguisi-on, panguluan, bambulao, lali, balin-sog, bala, socol (gala fish) pasayan, bilong-bilong, or tuban, or fresh water eel (casili) or agok-ok, and other big fishes not mentioned in 2nd, 3rd and 4th classes-----	P.04 per kilo.
Second class:	Bolinao, eulapi, langari, pangan, tigi, or any kind of fresh water fish, except those fresh water fishes mentioned in first class-----	P.03 per kilo.
Third class:	Iho, pagul, loned-----	.02 per kilo.
Fourth class:	Any other fish not included in the above classification-----	.01 per kilo.
	Sea Turtle, large-----	P1.00 each
	Sea Turtle, small-----	.50 each

SLAUGHTER FEE

Carabao or buffalo-----	P10.00 per head
Cow-----	5.00 " "
Horse-----	4.00 " "
Goat or sheep-----	.50 " "
Pig (dressed meat)-----	.05 per kilo
Roasted pig-----	.50 per head

SECTION 3. Time of payment.—Each and every market
vendor shall pay to the market collector the market or slaughter
fee immediately upon entering the market premises; provided, how-
ever that permanent market vendors or occupants of market stalls
or fixed kiosks shall pay the fees between 7:00 o'clock and
11:00 o'clock in the morning every day, and provided, further
that failure to pay the said fee within the time herein pres-
cribed shall subject the delinquent vendor or occupant to a
penalty of twenty per centum (20%) of the fee, such increment
thereto to be added to the regular fee and accounted for in the
same manner.

**SECTION 4. Civil remedies for collection of market or
slaughter fees.**—The civil remedies for the collection of market
or slaughter fees, surcharges or other increment thereto resul-
ting from delinquency shall be (a) by distraint and levy of
personal property belonging to the delinquent market vendor or
occupant and (b) by judicial action and, either of these two
remedies or both simultaneously, may be pursued in the discre-
tion of the authorities having charge of the collection

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of such fees.

SECTION 5. Penalty.- Any person, company, or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine of not exceeding one hundred pesos or imprisonment of not exceeding one month or both, in the discretion of the court, in the case of company, held responsible for the violation committed by its agents or representative.

SECTION 6. Repeal.-Any ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
