RESOLUTION NO. 295

WHEREAS, public school teachers throughout
the Philippines, who are qualified Philippine Normal
Graduates are by departmental circulars, uniformly
given a monthly salary at the rate of not less than
One Hundred and fifteen (P115.00) pesos, Philippine
Currency;

WHEREAS, there are nine (9) public school teachers
who are teaching in the Ormoc City Intermediate Public
School (Ormoc City District I and II) and who, despite
being qualified Philippine Normal Graduates, are given
by the City of Ormoc a monthly compensation at the rate
of only One Hundred (P100.00) pesos as appearing in the
approved amended plantilla for the personnel of the public
schools of Ormoc City District I and II by the Secretary
of the Department of Finance, dated October 30, 1948;

WHEREAS, the same amended plantilla approved by
the Secretary of Finance as aforesaid has authorized salary
ratings of emergency temporary teachers who are mere high
school graduates at the rate of One Hundred (P100.00) pesos
a month; this fact, being evidently a gross injustice to
the Philippine Normal School graduates;

WHEREAS, this situation being anomalous, it is the
duty and moral obligation of the city officials of Ormoc
City to repair and make amends the apparent wrongs committed
against these self-sacrificing and deserving Philippine
Normal School graduates and be a bulwark against any move
tending to demoralize their faith in the fairness and jus-
tice of our government, not to mention that it is as well
the duty of us city officials to maintain at a high level
and efficient teaching force in our jurisdiction by giving
our teaching personnel a just and fair compensation for
their meritorious and deserving services.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councillor Teleron,

seconded by Councilor Yugenon,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt an appropriation Ordinance to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF P1,620.00 FOR THE DIFFERENCE IN THE SALARIES OF NINE P.N.S. 3. TEACHERS IN ORMOG CITY DISTRICT ONE AND TWO, FROM JULY 1, 1948 TO JUNE 30, 1949.

Be It Ordained, by the Municipal Board, of Ormoc City and by authority of the same that:

SECTION 1.- The sum of P1,620.00 is hereby appropriated for the difference in the salaries of Nine(9) Philippine Normal School teachers of Ormoc City (Seven P.N.S. teachers of Ormoc District I and two P.N.S. teachers of Ormoc District II) District I and II, each from the rate of P100.00 to P115.00 monthly, beginning July 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949.

SECTION 2.- That said appropriation of P1,620.00 should be taken from the unappropriated balance of the Ormoc City intermediate school savings as of July 1, 1948.

SECTION 3.- The City Treasurer of Ormoc City, is hereby authorized, to prepare a Supplemental Budget for the purpose, and

SECTION 4.- That copies of this resolution and Ordinance be sent to the Honorable Secretary, Department of Finance, Manila, respectfully requesting his approval; to the Honorable Jose Avelino, President of the Senate and to the Honorable Carlos S. Tan, Senator-at-large, Congress of the Philippines, Manila, for their information and favorable recommendation.
