RESOLUTION NO. 103

The Board, on motion of Councillor Flaviano Montecelares,
seconded by Councillor Victorino C. Toleron;

BE IT RESOLVED, to approve the following quoted ordinance
as follows, viz:

ORDINANCE NO. 2

PROVISIONS GOVERNING THE CATCHING OF ASTRAY PIGS

SECTION 1. The words "ASTRAY PIGS" used in this ordinance
shall include all loose pigs roaming, destroying the appearance
or orderliness of the public places as streets, plazas, and
private premises.

SECTION 2. Every owner of pig or pigs must keep them
in the pens which are always kept clean and sanitary to
prevent the disturbance of neighbors from obnoxious odor.

SECTION 3. The City Health Officer is only authorized
official to appoint astray pig catchers whose remuneration
or emolument is two pesos (P2.00) for every pig caught by
the pig catcher or catchers.

SECTION 4. For every pig caught, the owner has the
obligation to pay P2.00, and fifty centavos (P.50) for every
day detention or fraction thereof in the compound, and after
five days detention if the owner could not redeem, the
pig will be sold at public auction and the sale is applied
for payment or charge. The surplus of the sale, if any, is
returned to the owner of the pig sold at auction.

SECTION 5. Any person or owner of pig or pigs viola-
ting or assisting in the violation of any part of parts of
these regulations shall, upon conviction be fined not less
than five pesos (P5.00) and not more than fifty pesos (P50.00)
or by imprisonment not less than five days nor more than
fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the
discretion of the court.

SECTION 6. This ordinance must take effect 5 days after
the handillo.
