RESOLUTION NO. 164

The Board, on motion of Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros, seconded by Councilor Pablo S. Pajaron:

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to amend Sec. 1 and Sec. 2 of Ordinance No. 12, series of 1945 and to add Sec. 2-b of Said Sec. 2 of Ordinance No. 12, so as to read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 12, SERIES OF 1945

SECTION 1.- In order to safeguard the Health and promote the welfare of the public, henceforth, all employees, laborers and helpers in any cafe, restaurant, hotel, bakeries, sari-sari stores, beverages stores, carinderias, panciterias, refreshment parlors, fish and meat vendors and ambulant food vendors and any person now engaged or hereafter may engage in the manufacture and sale of any kind of foods, operated within the jurisdiction of the City of Ormoc, shall submit for medical or physical examination to the Health Officer of this city or his authorized representatives once every three months, renewable thereafter.

SECTION 2.-For every medical certificate issued by the local Health Officer (or his duly authorized representative in favor of any individual employee or laborer or helper the person so examined shall be required to pay one (P1.00) Peso to the City Treasurer of this City or his duly authorized representative if this employee, laborer or helper is engaged or hereafter may engage in any Cafe, Restaurant, Hotel, Bakeries, Sari-sari Stores, Beverage Stores, Carinderias, Panciterias, Refreshment Parlors, Fish and Meat Vendors.

SECTION 2-b. For every medical certificate issued by the local health or his duly authorized representative in favor of any ambulant Food Vendors now engaged or hereafter may engage in the sale of Balannoy, Camote, Ledgid, Bodbod, Poto, Bebingka, Beko and ambulant Ice Cream dealer, the person so examined shall be required to pay thirty (P0.30) Centavon

to the City Treasurer this City or his duly authorized representative.

SECTION 3.-Penalty: Any person, firm, company or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance a fine or penalty of not more than Two hundred (P200.00) Pesos or an imprisonment of not more than Six (6) months or both such fine and imprisonment shall be imposed at the discretion of the Court. In case of a company, corporation or association the President or Manager of such company, corporation or association shall be held responsible for any violation committed by their subordinates.

SECTION 4.-Repeal: Any provision or provisions of any ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effectivity: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
