RESOLUTION NO. 11

The Board, on motion of Councilor Alvaro I. Gutierrez,
seconded by Councilor Victorino C. Teleron:

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE
SALE OF FOODS AND DRINKS
IN THE CITY OF ORMOC.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City
that:

SECTION I.- The word "Food" used in this ordinance
shall include all articles used by man for food, food
products, drink, liquor, confectionary, condiment, whether
simple, mixed or compound.

SECTION II. No person shall engage in the business of
restaurant, hotel, lunch counter, grocery, carinderia, pa-
citeria, fruit store, ice-cream parlor, refreshment parlor,
bar, push-cart, wagon, sarisari store, ambulant vendor, or
any place where food or food products within the meaning
of the word as herein described, are stored, prepared,
handled, sold, exchanged, offered for sale, given away, or
intended for human consumption, without first obtaining
a permit for the conduct of said place of business as above
enumerated, from the City Health Officer.

SECTION III. Such permit, unless revoked, shall be
good for one year and shall be conspicuously displayed in
the place of business for which it was issued, together
with a copy of this ordinance governing the sale of food
and drink. Permit issued under this ordinance is not trans-
ferable, and shall not be issued until full compliance
with the terms of this ordinance has been fulfilled.

SECTION IV. No person shall hereafter engage in a
business as described in Section 2, unless in possession
of a certificate from the City Health Officer certifying
that she or he has been examined by him within the last

thirty days and at that time was free from any contagious infectious or communicable disease of any nature. Each person engaged in any capacity in the business her in described shall be vaccinated against smallpox and given three (3) consecutive injections of C.S.T. of one week or seven (7) days intervals. This certificate shall be issued, displayed and revocable under the same conditions and restrictions described in Section 3, in relation to permits.

SECTION V.- No person shall engage in the business herein described or shall maintain in the premises, cart, wagon, stand, or shall prepare, store, handle, sell, offer for sale, or give away, barter or exchange any food within the meaning of the word as used herein which is not clean, pure and wholesome protected from contamination and suitable for human consumption within the broadest meaning of this term.

SECTION VI. Each person engage in the business as herein described shall at all times maintain the premises of the place of business in a clean and sanitary condition. The place shall be well illuminated and ventilated, free from vermin, foul odor, dust, dirt, accumulation of waste and refuse of all character.

SECTION VII. No fruits, vegetables, puto, calamay, sicharron, sugar, lechon, bibinca, empanada, siopao or other foods ordinarily eaten without further cooking shall be kept, offered for sale or given away at any place or transported within the territory described in these regulations, unless covered, screened, placed in transparent bag container or otherwise protected from insects, contact with animals, and handling by the public. The place of mosquito netting or similar material in direct contact with the foods shall not be considered covering, screening or protecting within the meaning of this ordinance.

SECTION VIII. All utensils used in preparation, served, for the sale of any food or drink within the meaning of these words as herein described, shall be properly and adequately cleaned after being used and no such utensils shall under any circumstances be used for the second time unless it shall have been, after such use thereof, be cleaned. In such cleaning the use of water which has become insanitary from previous use or water which has not been certified as safe and suitable for human consumption by the health authorities is prohibited.

SECTION IX. All establishment or vestibule in business purposes shall provide and antipolo privy, its equivalent which is empty illuminated, ventilated, properly and adequately screened and otherwise made fly-proof; and the receptacle properly constructed and adequately maintained. All privies shall be located at a proper distance from the place of business.

SECTION X. All establishments shall provide washing facilities, ample for use of the employees and customers, and these facilities shall at all times be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition. Running water from an elevated container, soap, and individual clean towels shall be furnished.

SECTION XI. All persons engaged in the business as herein described, shall provide suitable receptacles for all garbage, refuse and waste. Such receptacles shall be ample in size and sufficient in quantity to meet the needs of the business, constructed with a tight-fitting cover of metal. All garbage, waste, refuse, or other matter within the meaning of these terms shall be removed, burned, buried or otherwise destroyed at least once every 24 hours.

SECTION XII. The water supply for all places of business, as above described, shall be ample in quantity and obtained from a source which has been certified by the health authorities as safe and suitable for human consumption.

SECTION XIII. Any person or persons violating or assisting in the violation of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than P5.00 or more than P50.00 or by imprisonment for not more than one month or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court, and each day continuance of the condition shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. The violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance by any person holding a permit issued under its authority shall be deemed sufficient cause for revocation of such permit by the City Health Officer of whatever findings of the Court.

SECTION XIV. Any ordinance, orders or regulations inconsistent herewith are repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION XV. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

SECTION V. Let copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Honorable Executive Secretary, Malacañan Palace, Manila; the Hon. City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City; City Health Officer, Ormoc City; City Attorney, Ormoc City; Municipal Judge, Ormoc City; Chief of Police, Ormoc City; City Engineer, Ormoc City; Market Superintendent, Ormoc City, and copies to be posted in public places, Ormoc City.
