RESOLUTION NO. 208

The Board, on motion of Councilor Cesar Samson,  
seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to  
adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. XVI

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LEVY OF FIFTEEN CENTAVOS  
(P0.15) PER PETROLEUM CAN OF SALTED FISH MEN-  
TIONED IN ITEM B-11 OF ORDINANCE NO. 16, SER-  
IES OF 1948 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. VII,  
SERIES OF 1956 UPON BEING UNLOADED IN ORMOC  
CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc  
City, That:

SECTION 1. There shall be levied and collected  
from each and every person, company, firm or corpora-  
tion who brings and unloads in Ormoc City salted  
bolinao, hipon, sisi, libod and maubgas, fifteen  
centavos (P0.15) per petroleum can, whether they are  
brought in for sale in Ormoc City or not, provided  
they are unloaded within the jurisdiction of the  
City; Provided, However, that when the levy on such  
salted fish mentioned above is already collected  
outside the market premises, the entry of same into  
the market buildings and its premises shall be  
exempt from the payment of market fees provided for  
in Item B-11, Section 1, Ordinance No. 16, series  
of 1948, as amended by Ordinance No. VII, series  
of 1956.

SECTION 2. Any person, company, firm or corpora-  
tion found violating the provisions of this Ordinance  
shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine of not  
more than One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) or an imprison-  
ment of not exceeding one month, or both fine and  
imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. In  
case of company, firm or corporation the manager or  
president thereof, as the case may be, shall be held



liable for the violations committed by its agents  
or representatives.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or parts thereof in-  
consistent with this ordinance or parts hereof, is  
hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect immediately  
upon approval by the City Mayor of Ormoc.


