RESOLUTION NO. 88

"WHEREAS, In an inspection conducted by the Fire Department of this City of all business establishments it has been found out that only a few have installed fire fighting equipments in their business establishments;

"WHEREAS, in order to prevent or minimize the spread of fire in case of conflagration, this Body deemed it wise to require all business establishments in the City of Ormoc with a capital of \$\overline{P}500\$ or more to provide their stores with at least one fire extinguisher;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Alvaro I. Gutierrez, seconded by Councilor Jorge P. Tan, Jr.;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. IV

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS 9-10-1669
WITH A CAPITAL OF \$\interlightarrow\$500 OR MORE IN THE CITY OF
ORMOC TO INSTALL IN THEIR STORES AT LEAST
ONE FIRE EXTINGUISHER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Every person, firm, company or corporation running a business establishment or operating and maintaining a store or stores in the City of Ormoc with a capital of five hundred pesos (₱500) or more, is required to install in their respective stores or establishment fire extinguishers, the size and number of which is to be determined according to the size of the store or establishment and the volume of the business, but in no case it be less than one (1) fire extinguisher;

SECTION 2. Fire extinguisher as required in this Ordinance shall be placed in a conspicuous place of the store or establishment, easily within the reach in case of emergency.

SECTION 3. In determining the size and quantity
of the fire extinguisher to be installed in each store
or establishment, the minimum height of the tube must
be 24 inches and for stores or establishments with a
capital of \$\mathbb{P}2,000\$ or more, at least two tubes of this

SECTION 4. Any person, firm, company or corporation found violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction by a competent court, be punished by a fine of not more than fifty pesos (₱50) at the discretion of the court, and in case of firm, company or corporation, the manager, president or head thereof, as the case may be, shall be the one held responsible.

SECTION 5. Any resolution, Ordinance of parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance or parts hereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect as of the day next following the thirtieth (30th) day after the approval of this Ordinance by the City Mayor of Ormoc.
