RESOLUTION NO. 93

"WHEREAS, It has been noted that in the past administration collections of rentals from occupants of public market stalls have not been effected efficiently;

"WHEREAS, It has been found out that delinquencies have been rampant in the past administration, public market stall occupants have been allowed to stay and occupy their stalls without paying the necessary stall rentals for so many months, that some have accummulated delinquencies for six months or even more, despite the fact that public market stall occupants are required to pay their rentals daily;

"WHEREAS, In order to avoid and to discourage delinquents among public market stall occupants, this
Body deems it wise to regulate and limit delinquencies
to thirty days, after which they should be ejected
from their stalls;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Cesar Samson, seconded by Councilor Abvaro I. Gutier-rez and Vice Mayor Rafael M. Mejia;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. V

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LIMITING THE OCCUPANCY OF DELENQUENT PUBLIC MARKET STALL
OCCUPANTS OF ORMOC CITY TO THIRTY DAYS, AND
PROVIDING AS PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, EJECTMENT FROM THEIR STALLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm, company or corporation occupying a stall or stalls in the Public Market of Ormoc City shall pay rentals for the use or occupancy thereof, on a daily basis, payable daily, pursuant to Sections 10, 11 and 12 of Ordinance No. 5, series of 1951, as amended;

(RES. NO. 93, s. 1956, EMBODYING ORD. NO. V con'd.)

SECTION 2. Any occupant who is delinquent in the payments of his rentals equivalent to thirty (30) days shall be ejected thereform without prejudice to his reinstatement upon payment of the full delinquency, subject to a surcharge of twenty percentum (20%); PROVIDED, however, no other person or persons has applied and occupied the same stall or stalls for the duration of the ejectment;

SECTION 3. Any resolution, ordinance or part thereof which is inconsistent hereof is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect immediately upon its approval by the City Mayor of Ormoc.

"RESOLVED FURTHER, to authorize the City Treasurer of Ormoc City to notify occupants of public market stalls who are to be ejected, ten days before their ejectment from said stall or stalls;

"RESODVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to the Honorable Executive Secretary, Malacañang, Manila; the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the City Attorney, the Municipal Judge and the Market Superintendent, all of Ormoc City.
