RESOLUTION NO. 105

"WHEREAS, the Office of the City Engineer, Ormoc City, submitted to this Body a plan establishing an industrial zone in Ormoc City and regulating rhe location of industrial establishments in such a manner as to confine them in the industrial zone specified in the zonification plan;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Jorge P. Tan, Jr., seconded by Councilors Alvaro I. Gutierrez and Cesar Samson;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. IX
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE LOCATION
OF INDUSTRIAL ZONES WITHIN THE CITY OF ORMOC
AND REQUIRING INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE
CITY TO TRANSFER THEIR ESTABLISHMENTS TO THE
INDUSTRIAL ZONE WITHIN A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS,

AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. There shall be created in the City of Ormoc, a zonification as designated hereunder:

INDUSTRIAL ZONE "A"

DESCRIPTION: This area shall include all portion of land bounded by the lines described as follows:

Starting at point marked "1" of the Ormoc Townsite Map, a line is run along Real Street to the north to point "2"; thence a line is run along Anilao River (downstream) to point "32; thence a line is run to the East to the point of Origin.

ORMOC CITY

INDUSTRIAL ZONE "B"

DESCRIPTION: This area shall include all portion of land bounded by the lines described as follows:

Starting at point marked "1" of the Ormoc Townsite Map, a line is run along Juan Luna Street to the South to point "2"; thence a line is run along Burgos Street to the East to point "3"; thence a line is run along William Bryan Street to the South to point "4"; thence a line is run along the shore line of Ormoc Bay to the West to point "5"; thence a line is run along the Dike to Northsouth to point "6"; thence a line is run along C. Aviles Street to the point of Origin.

INDUSTRIAL ZONE "C"

DESCRIPTION: This area shall include all portion of land bounded by the lines described as follows:

Starting at point marked "1" of the Ormoc Town-site Map, a line is run along San Pablo Dike to North-south to point "2"; thence a line is run along C. Aviles Street to point "3"; thence a line is run along Malbasag River (downstream) and along the shore line of Ormoc Bay to the point of Origin.

INDUSTRIAL ZONE "D"

DESCRIPTION: This area shall include all portion of land bounded by the lines described as follows:

Starting at point marked "1" of the Ormoc Townsite Map, a line is run along Harrison Street to
South Southeast to point "2"; thence a line is run
along Sta. Cruz Street to Southwest to point "3";
thence a line is run along Del Carmen Street to
South Southeast to point "4"; thence a line is run
along the shore line of Ormoc Bay and along the
Malbasag River (upstream) to the point of Origin.

INDUSTRIAL ZONE "E"

DESCRIPTION: This area shall include add portion of land bounded by the lines described as follows:

Starting at point marked "1" of the Ormoc Townsite Map, a line is run along San Pedro Street to North Northsouth to point "2"; thence a line is run along C. Aviles Street to point "3"; thence a line is run along San Pablo Dike to the shore line of Ormoc Bay; thence a line is run along the shore line of Ormoc Bay to the point of Origin.

SECTION 2. No corn and/or rice mills, lumber mills, factories, distilleries and all motors or power engines of 6 horsepower or more and any other form of machineries, emitting smoke, noise and/or dust, shall be constructed in the City, except in the place designated as "Industrial Zone", subject, however, to existing rules and regulations of other departments of the city.

ORMOC CITY

SECTION 3. All corn and/or rice mills, lumber mills, factories, distilleries and all motors or power engines of 6 horsepower or more and any other form of machineries emitting smoke, noise and/or dust, already constructed in places outside the the designated "Industrial Zone" shall be given a grace period of two (2) years from the effectivity of this Ordinance to transfer them to the place designated as "Industrial Zone", subject, however, to the rules and regulations as the City Health Officer and City Engineer may promulgate.

SECTION 4. Penalty. - Any person, owner or operator violating any of the provision of this Ordinance or part hereof, shall upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction, be penalized by a fine of not more than \$200.00 or an imprisonment of not less than 2 months nor more than six (6) months, or both fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance takes effect two (2) years after its approval by the City Mayor of Ormoc.

SECTION 6. Any resolution or ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance or parts hereof, are hereby repealed.
