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ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE HOLDING OF COCKFIGHTS IN DULY ESTABLISHED LICENSED COCKPITS IN CONNECTION WITH ANY NATIONAL FUND DRIVE FOR CHARITABLE AND CIVIC PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, That:

SECTION 1. COCKFIGHTS ON SATURDAYS MAY BE PERMITTED.- In connection with any national fund drive for charitable and civic purposes, the City Mayor is hereby authorized to issue a permit for the holding of cockfighting on Saturdays as the Municipal Board may determine but not to exceed the period of time officially set and designated as the duration of the National Fund Drive as indicated in an Executive Order or Proclamation issued by the President of the Philippines.

SECTION 2. SHARE OF THE ENTITY.- Out of the gross earnings of the cockpit on that day, twenty-five per cent (25%) shall be deposited with the City Treasurer or his authorized representative not later than the following day in the name of, and as share of the particular entity in whose favor the fund campaign is authorized to be undertaken; PROVIDED: HOWEVER, that when a legal holiday in which cockfighting is permitted by law falls on a Saturday, the City Government shall not share as above provided in the gross income of the cockpit on that day.

SECTION 3. INCOME TO CONSTITUTE A SPECIAL FUND.- The share of the entity shall constitute a special fund to be used solely as contribution of the City to the National Fund Drive so designated in Section 1 for the satisfaction of its quota.

SECTION 4. PROPER TICKETS RECEIPTS TO BE KEPT.- In order to determine the amount constituting the share of the entity, the proprietor or operator of the cockpit shall cause to be printed or legibly typed, tickets made specially for the Saturday cockfights to be used at the general entrance or at the entrance to the bleachers or grandstand and submitted previously to the City Treasurer for proper countersigns and numbering. Proper receipts for the amounts of bets in favor of each contending rooster and deposited with the casador on each encounter or soltada and on vendor's fees and other fees paid to the cockpit proprietor or operator shall be kept and submitted to the City Treasurer for verification each depositing day.

SECTION 5. THE AUDITING OF FUNDS AND ENFORCEMENT OF COLLECTION.- The entity concerned is hereby given the rights to check and audit the gross earnings of the cockpit on the day assigned in its favor and to bring any action which may be proper in the premises for the collection of its share.

SECTION 6. GAMBLING PROHIBITED.- No card game of chance of any kind shall be permitted on the premises of the cockpit.


SECTION 7. COCKFIGHTING PROHIBITED ON SPECIAL DAYS.- No cock-fighting shall be held on July 4, and on December 30 although these dates or any of which will fall on a Saturday.

SECTION 8. PENALTY.- Any proprietor or operator of a cockpit who violates the provisions of Sections 5 or 6 of this Ordinance will be punished, upon conviction by a fine of not more than P100.00 or imprisonment of not more than one month, or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court. A violation of any other provision will subject the violator to civil indemnity for the loss and damages sustained by the entity concerned. In either case, the cockpit license will be cancelled.


SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


