RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CERTIFICATES OF PAYMENT FOR GARABAGE COLLECTION SERVICE ON ALL BUSINESSES, TRADES OR OCCUPATIONS, AND RESIDENCES; IMPOSING FEES AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF ALL COLLECTION EXPENSE FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Orooc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Orooc City, That:

SECTION 1. Certificate required.— All persons and/or entities conducting, maintaining, operating or engaged in any of the businesses, trades or occupations, or all occupants of residential houses enumerated in Item 66 of Section 3 of this Ordinance, shall be required to secure from the City Treasurer a Certificate of Payment for Garbage Collection Service. In the case of those persons who, at the time of the effectivity of this ordinance, are already engaged in the business, trades or occupations enumerated hereunder, such Certificate of Payment for Garbage Collection Service shall be secured within twenty (20) days from the date of said effectivity of this ordinance, while in the case of those who, after the effectivity of this ordinance, will engage in the businesses, trades or occupations, the same certificate shall be secured within twenty (20) days from the date they established their businesses, trades, or occupations. Failure to secure such certificate in either case within the period mentioned above shall be subject to an additional charge of fifty (50%) percentum of the original fee which shall be collected in the same manner and at the same time as the original fee. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that any occupant of a house the assessed value of which is P1,000 or more who is not otherwise classified under Section 3 shall be required to obtain the certificate above mentioned within the period provided for.

SECTION 2. Applications: contents of.- All persons required to secure the Certificate of Payment for Garbage Collection Service shall file with the City Treasurer an application in writing on the form prescribed by said officer for the purpose.

SECTION 3. Fees.- There shall be paid to the City Treasurer for every Certificate of Payment for Garbage Collection Service, as required under the provisions of Section 1 hereof, an annual fee in accordance with the following schedule of rates:

Provided, that any person or entity engaged in two or more businesses, trades or occupations located in one and the same place, store or establishment shall pay one fee only that which is the higher or the highest, as prescribed herein; Provided, Further, that any person or entity whose business, trade or occupation is located at a place not accessible to the collection of refuse, and where collection and disposal service of whatever nature is not being rendered by the City, shall be excepted from the payment of the annual fees for which a certificate of payment is required as herein provided, in which case a certification to that effect shall be issued by the Office of the City Engineer.

(SECTION 4. Definition.- For the purpose of this Ordinance,  
the following definitions shall apply:

(a) Any waste matter or debris that is deposited in the  
place designated by the City Engineer or City Health  
Officer for such purpose shall be considered garbage  
or rubbish.

(b) "Occupants" is defined as any person or persons who  
has the natural possession of the house and who is  
responsible for the cleanliness and sanitation of the  
same.

SECTION 5. Certificates issued in accordance with this Ord-  
inance shall expire on the thirty-first day of December, renewable  
on or before the twentieth day of January every year. Certi-  
ficates not renewed within that period shall be subject to a  
surcharge of fifty percentum (50%) of the prescribed fee which  
shall be collected in the same manner and at the same time as  
the prescribed fee.

SECTION 6. Penalties.- Any person who is required to obtain  
a certificate of payment for garbage collection service who  
shall fail to comply with the provisions hereof shall be punished  
by a fine of not less than fifty pesos nor more than two hundred  
pesos, or by imprisonment for not less than one month nor more  
than six months or both fine and imprisonment in the discretion  
of the court. By the City Treasurer, may in his discretion,  
proceed against any person who shall be found delinquent in the  
payment of the fees prescribed above by levy or distraint of his  
property to enforce payment of the same.

SECTION 7. Use of fees collected.- All fees collected in  
connection with the provisions of this ordinance shall be ex-  
clusively expended in the operation of the garbage collection  
service.

SECTION 8. The City Engineer is hereby authorized to pres-  
cribe rules and regulations regarding garbage collection and  
disposal in the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 9. Heretofore.- All ordinances or parts of ordinances  
inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby  
repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 10. Effectivity.- This ordinance shall take effect  
ten (10) days after the approval of the Mayor.
