RESOLUTION NO. 94

"WHEREAS, Art. 62 (Rules and Regulations in Connection with the Presentation of Plan) in connection with Article 1, Ordinance No. 2, s. 1950 (Building Ordinance for Ormoc City), specified, among other things, that the permit issued by the City Mayor in connection with building constructions in accordance with the aforesaid ordinance, shall be duly signed by the City Health Officer, and the Chief, Fire Department;

"WHEREAS, for purposes of determining the assessed value of the building under construction, the City Assessor requested the enclosure in Article 62 a proviso that he also sign the permit for such construction;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Ocubillo;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES OF 1950, ENTITLED "BUILDING ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF ORMOC."

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Article 1 of Ordinance No. 2, series of 1950, entitled "Building Ordinance for the City of Ormoc", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"ARTICLE 1.-PERMIT

Before any person, firm, corporation or entity starts to construct, repair, modify or alter any structure or building in the City of Ormoc, the owner or his authorized representative shall apply and secure from the office of the City Engineer a permit for same, signed by the City Health Officer, the City Assessor, the Chief, Fire Department, and be duly approved by the City Mayor. The construction, repair, modification or alteration of any structure or building prior to securing the necessary permit shall be considered illegal and, therefore, such structure is subject to demolition and removal if the City Engineer deems necessary."



SECTION 2. Article 62 (Rules and Regulations in Connection with the Presentation of Plan) of Ordinance No. 2, series of 1950, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Art. 62 - Rules and Regulations in Connection With the Presentation of Plan.

All plans shall be presented in six copies; one should be of tracing cloth or paper in ink, and the other five should be blue print copies. Each of the blue print copies shall be remained in the Offices of the City Mayor, the City Engineer, the City Health Officer, the City Assessor and the Chief, Fire Department. the tracing cloth or paper in ink shall be returned to the owner. The blue print copies shall be very legible otherwise same shall be rejected.

The permit should be duly signed by the City Engineer, the City Health Officer, the City Assessor and the Chief, Fire Department, approved by the City Mayor.

SECTION 3. Effectivity. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon approval.






