RESOLUTION NO. 126
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES OF 1960.

The Board, on motion of Councilor Francisco D. Abas, seconded by Councilor Benjamin T. Pongos;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE SHIPMENT OF HOGS, PIGS OR SWINE FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES FROM ORMOC CITY TO ANY PLACE IN THE PHILIPPINES.

Be it ordained by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION I. That the shipment of hogs, pigs or swine for commercial purposes from Ormoc City to Manila or any place in the Philippines, be limited to 250 heads per week shipment.

SECTION II. - That shippers of hogs, pigs or swine for commercial purposes to be shipped to Manila or any place in the Philippines from Ormoc City shall first secure or obtain permit from the Office of the City Mayor of Ormoc City, after proper inspection by the Meat Inspectors duly authorized or any representative of the Bureau of Animal Industry.

SECTION III. - That for every permit issued by the City Mayor's office a fee of Two Pesos shall be paid.

SECTION IV. That the City May or or in his absence or incapacity the Vice Mayor, shall determine the allocation or distribution as to the number each shipper or hog dealer is entitled to ship per week shipment for commercial purposes from Ormoc City to any place in the Philippines, but in no case exceed 250 heads per week; Provided that duly licensed hog or pig dealers at the time of the passage of this ordinance who may be put out of bisiness, must in one week, notify in writing the Mayor or the City Treasurer of such fact;

SECTION V.- That only duly licensed pig or hog dealers are covered by this ordinance. By "duly licensed pig or hog dealers" is meant those shippers of five (5) or more hogs, pigs or swine

per shipment outside of Ormoc City.

SECTION VI.- Penalty.- Any person or persons, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Fifty (P50.00) pesos but not more than Two hundred (P200.00) pesos, or an imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days or both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court, in addition to the cancellation of his license as pig or hog dealer.

SECTION VII. - Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this ordinance each to the Honorable Executive Secretary, Malacañang, Manila; the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the City Health Officer, the Meat Inspectors, representative of the Bureau of Animal Industry, and copies posted in conspicuous public places, all of Ormoc City.
