RESOLUTION NO. 100

The Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilor Conopio;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING, DISTRIBUTION AND/OR DISPLAY OF FISHES, ARTICLES, COMMODITIES AND THINGS ALONG THE MARKET SIDEWALK AND PATHWAY FRONTING THE VEGETABLES SECTION OF THE PUBLIC MARKET OF OFMOC CITY, AND PROVIDING PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Rep. Act 179 as amended by Rep. Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell, display or distribute any fish or fishes, article or articles, commodity or commodities, thing or things, etc. along the sidewalk and pathway fronting the vegetable section of the public market of Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished with a fine of not less than two pesos (\$\frac{1}{2}.00\$) but not more than five pesos (\$\frac{1}{2}.00\$) or an imprisonment of not less than two days but not more than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3. The term "sidewalk" of the public market shall be understood to mean the cement sidewalk running from East to West; and the term "pathway" refers to the ground pathway (now also cemented) running from East to West located between the vegetable section and fish section of the public market.

SECTION 4. Any previous ordinance inconsident with this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
