RESOLUTION NO. 224

"WHEREAS, with the appointment recently of a City Veterinarian it becomes necessary to define the status of the operation of the city abattoir and the powers and duties of the city veterinarian;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilor Conopio;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE STATUS OF THE OPERATION OF THE CITY ABATTOIR AND ITS HEAD, WITH HIS POWERS AND DUTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, That:

SECTION 1. The operation of the city abattoir is hereby made a separate and distinct division of the Government of Ormoc City. Its head shall be the City Veterinarian who, together with those working under him, shall be subject to the supervision of the Mayor of Ormoc City and to the control of the Director of the Bureau of Animal Industry. The duties and powers of the city veterinarian shall be as follows:

- (a) To supervise and control meat inspection in Ormoc City;
- (b) To perform milk inspection;
- (c) To train aspirants for meat inspection work;
- (d) To take charge of any zoological garden that the city may establish and maintain in the future;
- (e) To apprehend clandestine slaughter;
- (f) To detect and control animal epizootics and to perform vaccinations against rabies, hog cholera, pasteurellosis, anthrax, and other animal diseases;
- (g) To assist the veterinarians of the Bureau of Animal Industry in the enforcement of the regulations governing the inter-municipal movements of animals;
- (h) To assist the extension officers of the Bureau of Animal Industry in the dissemination of animal improvement work;
- (i) To supervise the proper sanitation of the abattoir and the work of its laborers;
- (j) To act as an expert in veterinary legal cases;
- (k) To inspect raw meat in the different pansiterias, hotels, restaurants, markets, and other food establishments;
- (l) To cooperate with the city treasurer in the collection of ante-mortem and slaughter fees;

- (m) To cooperate with the other city officials in all matters that affect the vital interests of the city;
- (n) To perform such other work as may be assigned by the Director of Animal Industry and such other work that may be suggested by the City Mayor from time to time in connection with the power of supervision of the abattoir.

SECTION 2. Any ordinance or section thereof in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon approval.
