RESOLUTION NO. 165

"WHEREAS, it is of common knowledge that the number of bicycles in Ormoc City has considerably increased, what with some residents owning several bicycles for rental purposes which has caused a tizzy among young boys and girls and even among older men and women to learn how to control and operate a bicycle, thus increasing traffic in the public streets of Ormoc City specially in the Poblacion;

"WHEREAS, this situation has given rise to many accidents on the road, endangering life and property and said situation is augmented by the devilry of many who allow two or more persons to ride on the same bicycle making the maneuverability of the bicycle more difficult and exposing the riders thereof to accidents;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Aviles, seconded by Councilor Parrilla;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BICYCLE TANDEM RIDING IN PUBLIC STREETS IN THE POBLACION OF ORMOC CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for two or more persons to ride on a bicycle in the public streets of the Poblacion of Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. Any person found violating the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than ONE PESO (P1.00) nor more than FIVE PESOS (P5.00) or by imprisonment of not more than two (2) days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall not apply to a person who, in answer to some humanitarian service or duty, carries or allows a person physically ill, hurt or unable to walk, on the bicycle to take him for prompt medical attention, or to the house of such person's parents, brothers, sisters, relatives or guardians, or when the person being carried or allowed to ride on is the father, wife, son or daughter of

the person controlling or operating the bicycle.

SECTION 4. By the term "bicycle tandem riding" is meant the riding on the bicycle by two or more persons.

SECTION 5. Any provision of existing ordinance inconsistent with the provisions hereof is hereby deemed repealed.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.






