"The Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by Councilor Abas;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. XIV, SERIES OF 1956, ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF ONE CENTAVO PER LITER
OF VOLUME CAPACITY OF GASOLINE SOLD WITHIN ORMOC CITY, AMENDING
FOR THE PURPOSE PARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION 2, ORDINANCE NO. 9,
SERIES OF 1948, ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE FIXING LICENSE FEES
FOR THE SALE OF GASOLINE, KEROSENE, PETROLEUM OR CRUDE OIL,
AND PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREOF' AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 9, series of 1949, as amend-
ed by Section 1 of Ordinance No. XIV, series of 1956, is hereby amended
further to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. - The license fees to be paid shall be as follows:

- (a) For every liter of gasoline sold, or high octane, or its equivalent, Two Centavos (P0.02);
- (b) For every tin of petroleum, kerosene or its equivalent, Twenty Centavos (P0.20); and
- (c) For every liter of diesel, crude oil, alcohol or its equivalent, One Centavo (P0.01).

PROVIDED, that the collection of license fees heretofore
made by the City Treasurer at the rate herein fixed is hereby
ratified by this Ordinance."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its
approval.


"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to authorize the City Treasurer to print copies

each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, and all concerned.


"CARRIED. Six affirmative votes registered by Councilors Tugonon,




