ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FURTHER SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 11,
SERIES OF 1964, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 16, SERIES
OF 1964, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE GRADUATED
MUNICIPAL, CAPITAL AND SALES TAX ON THE SALE OF MERCHANDISE
IN THE CITY OF ORMOC AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City. That:

SECTION 1. Further amendment. - Section 1, Ordinance No. 11, series
of 1964, as amended by Ordinance No. 16, series of 1964, is hereby amend-
ed further to read in full as follows:

"SECTION 1. Municipal tax. - There shall be paid to the
City Treasurer on any sale of merchandise and others except
abaca, hemp, copra, maguey, exported sugar, local centrifugal
sugar or domestic sugar and its derivatives, and the like by
any person, partnership, firm, association, corporation or
entity engaged in business or the like in the City of Ormoc
a graduated municipal, capital and sales tax per quarter as
follows:
