

"WHEREAS, this august Body will remember having passed Resolution No. 241 adopting Ordinance No. 19 on August 18, 1964, appropriating the amount of \$\mathbb{P}2,291\$ from out of the surplus appropriation for outstanding obligations in the Ormoc City Intermediate School Fund and reverting the amount of \$\mathbb{P}14,989\$ from out of the discretionary fund of His Honor, the City Mayor, for the salaries of nine new additional classroom teachers in the Ormoc City Intermediate School (seven for District I and two for District II):

"WHEREAS, on the second thought, this Board extremely feels that the said resolution-ordinance has been quite unfair to the Office of the City Mayor whose wings have been clipped by the sizeable reduction of his discretionary fund thereby crippling the functions of the office for whatever good it can do for exigency in the service which ultimately will redound to the general well-being of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, His Honor, the City Mayor, has in a communication dated August 17, 1964, returned the 1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget with his veto on thirteen items for reasons of economy and non-essentiality which this Body has overriden in toto by Resolution No. 242, current series;

Honorable City Mayor this august Body agrees with the former on the nonessentiality at least for the present of a Special Counsel in the Office
of the City Fiscal and this Body, likewise, considers the Mayor's reasons
for vetoing the items for partial payment of uncollected salaries of
Chief of Police Ciriaco Porcadilla and payment of unpaid salaries of
Crispin Sanchez under outstanding obligations in the Police Department;

WHEREAS, from out of the above-mentioned three items vetoed which this Body accedes to will mean a savings of \$\mathbb{P}\$11,026.24 which can more than meet the salaries of the nine new additional classroom teachers in the Ormoc City Intermediate School with compensation each at the rate of \$\mathbb{P}\$160 a month for seven months starting from August even as the release of appropriation for the nationalization of city intermediate schools remains pending;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Besabella, seconded by Councilors Tugonon and Du;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to repeal Resolution No. 241 adopting Ordinance No. 19, appropriating funds for the salaries of nine new additional classroom teachers in the City Intermediate School and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF ELEVEN THOUSAND TWENTY-SIX PESOS AND TWENTY-FOUR CENTAVOS (\$11,026.24) FROM CERTAIN VETOED ITEMS IN THE 1964-1965 ORMOC CITY BUDGET FOR THE SALARIES OF NINE NEW ADDITIONAL TEACHERS IN THE ORMOC CITY INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL FOR NINE MONTHS STARTING FROM AUGUST, 1964, PENDING RELEASE OF APPROPRIATION FOR THE NATIONALIZATION OF CITY INTERMEDIATE SCHOOLS

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of Eleven Thousand Twenty-Six Pesos and Twenty-Four Centavos or so much thereof is hereby reverted from the following items in the 1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget which have been vetoed by His Honor, the City Mayor, viz:

C-10, Office of the City Fiscal, Salaries and Wages, Item No. 6: One (1) Special Counsel ₹ 2,000,00

C-15, Police Department, Outstanding Obligations, Item No. 41: Partial payment of uncollected salaries of Chief Ciriaco Porcadilla

C-15, Police Department, Outstanding Obligations, Item No. 42: Unpaid salaries of Crispin Sanchez ...

said sum to be made available for the salaries of the nine new additional classroom teachers in the Ormoc City Intermediate School with compensation each at the rate of \$160.00 per month for the period of seven months starting from August, 1964, pending the release of appropriation for the nationalization of city intermediate schools.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as of August 1, 1964.

"RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the Director of Public Schools, Manila, the Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban City, and the District Supervisors (Ormoc I and Ormoc II), the City Auditor and the City Treasurer, all of Ormoc City;
