ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING ITEM NO. 15, C-2, MUNICIPAL BOARD, PAGE 5, UNDER SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 18, SERIES OF 1964, TO ITEM NO. 13, C-1, OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, PAGE 4 OF THE SAME, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Item No. 15, C-2, Municipal Board, page 5, under Section 1 of Ordinance No. 18, series of 1964, is hereby deleted and the same is hereby reverted to Item No. 13, C-1, Office of the City Mayor, page 4 of the same, so that the latter will read:

"Item No. 13 - The City Mayor's Commutable Allowance P 3,800.00"

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as of July 1, 1964.
