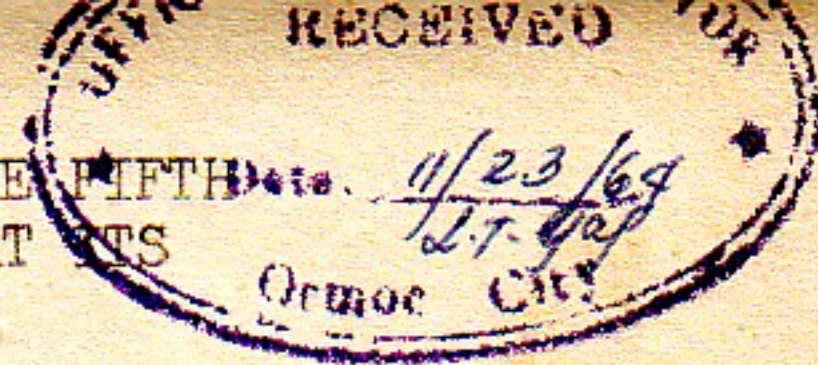

## RESOLUTION NO. 343

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Floor Leader Tugonon and Councilor Du;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING P500 EACH FOR GASOLINE ALLOWANCE OF THE CITY FISCAL AND THE CITY JUDGE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of P500 or so much thereof is hereby appropriated from funds not otherwise appropriated in the city treasury to be made available for gasoline allowance of the City Fiscal.

SECTION 2. The sum of P500 or so much thereof is hereby appropriated from funds not otherwise appropriated in the city treasury to be made available for gasoline allowance of the City Judge.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as of November 1, 1964.

ENACTED, November 18, 1964.
