RESOLUTION NO. 37

"WHEREAS, Councilor Du has quoted a portion of the letter of the Honorable Secretary of Finance dated Dec. 16, 1963, addressed to the City Mayor thru the City Treasurer, to wit: 'It is also noted that the City stands to incur an excess of ₱12,537.40 (3.4%) over the maximum amount expendable for salaries and wages this fiscal year';

"WHEREAS, this august Body is bent on adopting a retrenchment policy to tide the City over financial deficits as contemplated in its Resolution No. 28 to abolish unessential positions at the sacrifice of other positions and offices in the City Government;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by Councilor Alfaro;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITIONS OF STENOGRAPHER AND
MESSENGER-CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL BOARD

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

Section 1. The positions of Stenographer and Messenger-Clerk, both of the Municipal Board, Ormoc City, are hereby abolished, for purposes of economy.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, January 29, 1964.

"RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Stenographer and the Messenger-Clerk, both of the Municipal Board, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City;

"CARRIED. Six affirmative votes registered by Councilors Tugonon, Alfaro, Kierulf, Abas, Besabella and Du; One negative vote registered by Councilor Aviles."
