RESOLUTION NO. 102

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by Councilor Abas;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF LIQUOR AND/OR ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES TO, AND THE BUYING AND DRINKING OR IMBIBING OF
THE SAME BY, MINORS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, manager or person in
charge of any public bar, night club, dance hall, dancing school, public
club and any club, restaurant, cocktail lounge, refreshment parlor, ca-
renderia, grocery store, sari-sari store, or any store or establishment,
or for any peddler or vendor, to dispense, or sell, serve, or cause or
allow to be dispensed, sold or served, whether free of charge or for value,
any alcoholic beverage, drink or concoction such as whisky, brandy, rum,
cordial, liqueure, beer, wine, "tuba", "basi", and the like, to any person
of either sex who is under twenty-one years of age.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person of either sex who is
under twenty-one years to buy and drink or imbibe any alcoholic beverage,
drink or concoction specifically mentioned in Section 1 hereof in any of
the places specified herein or in any other public places.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not be applicable
to a minor of either sex who is sent on an errand merely to buy liquor
on order of his parents, guardians, elders or persons in charge of such
minor.

SECTION 4. Owners of establishments above-mentioned shall announce
to the public or shall display in their respective establishments the
provisions of this Ordinance by way of sign boards or notices in conspi-
cuous places.

SECTION 5. Violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be pu-
nishable by a fine of not less than Twenty Pesos (P20.00) or imprisonment
of not less than five (5) days but not more than thirty (30) days, or both
such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

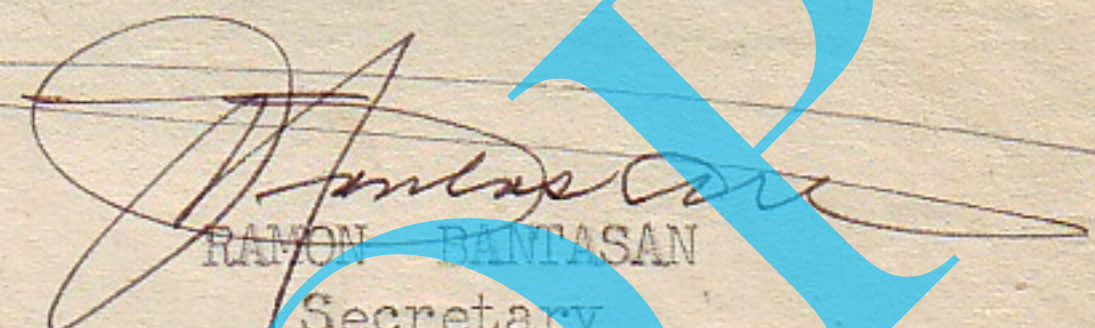
SECTION 6. Any provision of existing ordinances or parts thereof in-

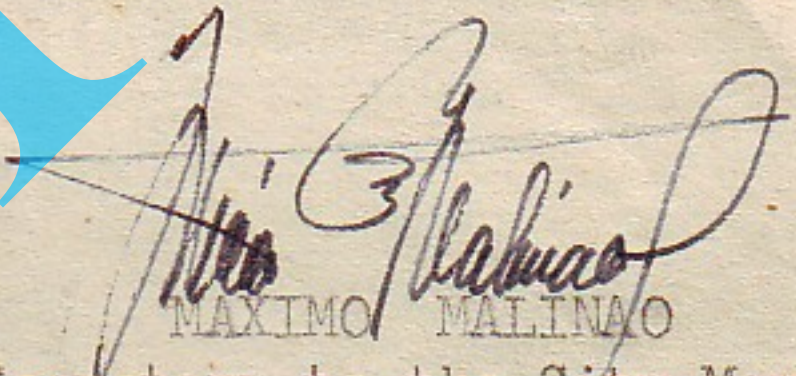
