RESOLUTION NO. 131

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by Councilor Tugonon;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A STORAGE TAX OF TWO PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (P2.50) FOR EVERY TON OF HEMP, MAGUEY, AND THE LIKE, AND TWENTY CENTAVOS (P0.20) FOR EVERY SACK OF COPRA PURCHASED, SOLD, STORED OR KEPT BY ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, FIRM, ASSOCIATION, CORPORATION, ETC., IN THE CITY OF ORMOG, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Municipal Tax. - Any person, partnership, firm, association or corporation duly licensed or engaged in buying and/or selling copra, hemp, maguey, and the like, who shall hold, keep or store the same at his place of business, bodega or elsewhere within the jurisdiction of the City of Ormoc, shall pay to the City Treasurer a storage tax of Two Pesos and Fifty Centavos (P2.50) for every ton of hemp, maguey, and the like, and Twenty Centavos (P0.20) for every sack of copra stored or kept by any person or entity subject of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Time and manner of payment and "penalty" for delinquency. - The municipal tax herein prescribed shall be payable without penalty within twenty (20) days after the close of the calendar month for which the tax is due. Failure to pay the tax within the prescribed time shall render the taxpayer subject to a surcharge of fifty percentum (50%) for the first offense and one hundred percentum (100%) for subsequent failures to pay within the prescribed period.

SECTION 3. "Penalty" for violation. - Any person, partnership, firm, association or corporation or entity who shall fail to pay the tax as above prescribed within the time specified therein shall suffer an imprisonment of six (6) months or a fine equivalent to the tax due plus twenty-five percentum (25%) surcharge, or both such imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4. Any provision in any existing ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be considered annulled, amended or of no effect.

SECTION. 5. Construction of this Ordinance. - If any part or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or ultra vires, such part or section shall not invalidate any other provisions hereof;

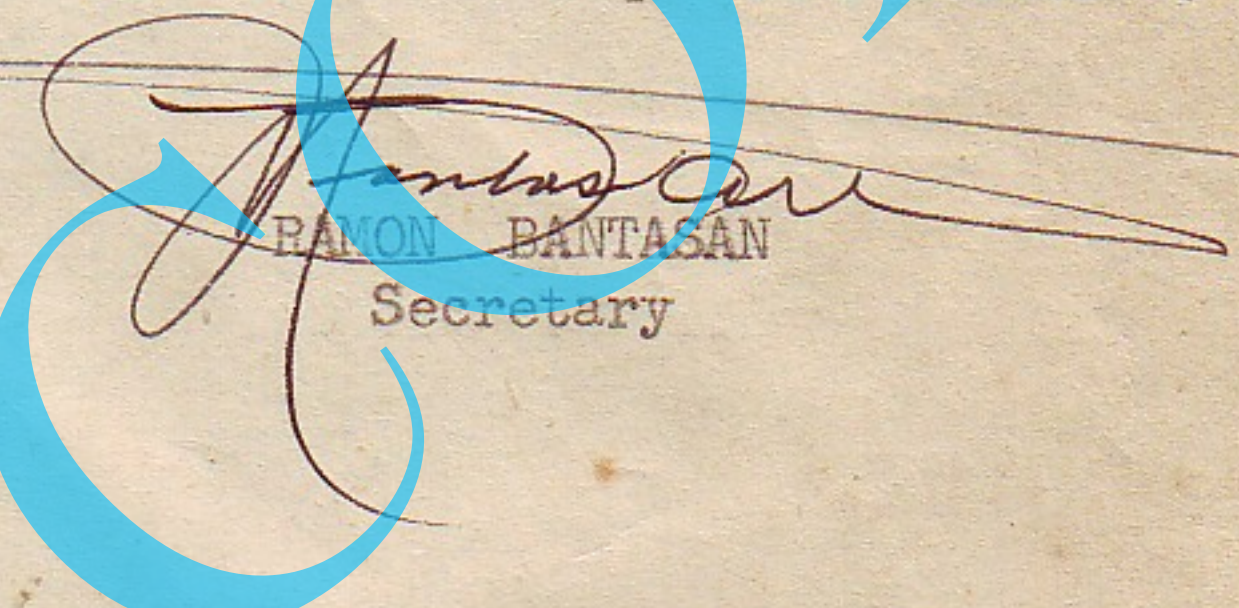
SECTION 6. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

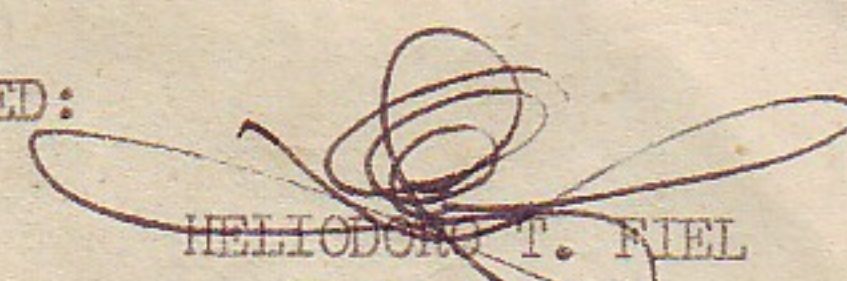

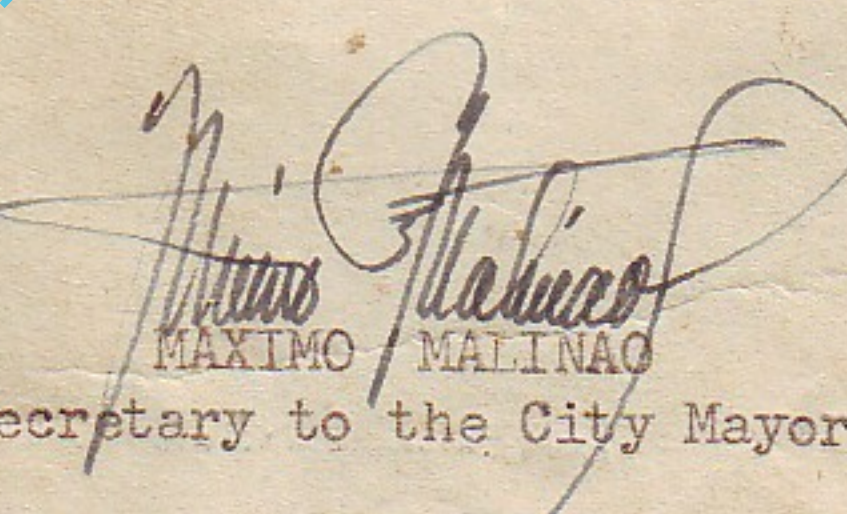
