"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CLEARANCE AND PERMIT FROM THE CITY MAYOR  
FOR HIRING SECURITY GUARDS, SPECIAL POLICEMEN OR WATCHMEN  
OF ESTABLISHMENTS DOING BUSINESS IN ORMOC CITY AND  
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,  
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended  
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Any partnership, firm, corporation or entity and the like  
doing business in Ormoc City and desiring to hire security guards, special  
policemen or watchmen for their business establishments shall secure the  
necessary clearance and permit from the City Mayor.

By the term "clearance" is meant certification to show that the per-  
son or the applicant for the position of security guard, special poli-  
man or watchman is of good moral character and without any crimi-  
cord.

SECTION 2. For purposes of this Ordinance, all existing  
guards, special policemen or watchmen within the territorial  
tion of Ormoc City shall be considered as new unless, other-  
have previously secured permits from the City Mayor.

SECTION 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ord  
be punishable by an imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days  
not exceeding thirty (30) days or a fine of not less than One Hundred  
Pesos (P100) but not exceeding Two Hundred Pesos (P200) or both such  
imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with  
the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accord-  
ly.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its  
proval.




